Best Bets: SMOKE WAGON (5th) – OLLIEMEISTER (6th)

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- HI HEELED WARRIOR Good effort behind big favorite when Kirby barn re-claimed; actual drop.
- R TENDERONI Chased loose pacesetter for higher tag; fired three of four races since return.
- CAPTIVATING CARA Weakened with quicker sprinting but led to final stages in prior route.
- RITAAN Humbled by runaway winner in second start after hiatus; eligible for non-winners of 3.

Race 2

- 2 LAST ROMANCE Ness barn 30% off claim; drops peg racing cheapest ever and late kick likely.
- SPEIGHTSTER RED Re-claimed by Lupe Guerrero barn where he achieved much success.
- RWANI Competed primarily on turf but can't dismiss this level; worked locally recently.
- LORD WINSALOT Faded after forcing pace as favorite but good before and removes blinkers.

Race 3

- HALEIGH B Difficult to like or ignore plunge in first local appearance; taken for \$30,000 earlier.
- 3 WISHING ONA PRAYER Used up dueling when overmatched but speedy threat this level.
- 2 OLD HEAD Exits game score when claimed for sixth time this season; weight off for this.
- BETWEEN DREAMS Outdueled by third pick when claimed; hit board in 17 of 24 attempts.

Race 4

- 4 ALYVIA MAVIS Rallied then faltered at top maiden level in route; outrun by newcomer prior try.
- IMPERIO AZTECA Game effort despite stumbling start as odds-on chalk; speed along inside.
- **12** FAST STORM Wide trip in debut when soundly beaten by top choice; progress anticipated.
- I AM RUE Just one length behind top pick as longshot and improving with each outing.

Race 5

- SMOKE WAGON Battled streaking winner in sprint; firing every start and showed route ability.
- LOST AND CONFUSED Versatile gelding chased smashing winner and taking aggressive drop.
- PATRIARCHAL Prominent throughout this spot and sold privately since; sharp each local try.
- PRINCE OF CHILL Usually gives his best but finished behind third pick; Padilla barn on a roll.

Race 6

- OLLIEMEISTER Led to late stages in longer test and closed big gap previously; handles these.
- JEBOLOGIST Pressed pace before fading behind top choice; prior try after layoff encouraging.
- HANEY BOYS Determined narrow score after layoff and possibility with logical next step.
- THE ANGRY MAN Rallied very wide at loftier level as longshot; needs help with pace scenario.

Race 7 PREDOMINATE – Stretch-runner with pair of sharp tries since claim; conqueror won allowance. ASSEMBLY POINT – Romped twice earlier with Lopez aboard and speed to pose major threat. YES SIR COLONEL – Veteran with 10 career victories beaten before and late kick anticipated. RERALLY – Sharp behind repeat winner this spot and several eventful trips in past. Race 8 TRADERS LUCK – Terrific speed when caught late at this yardage; among best claims locally. BORRACHO – Eight-year-old still rapid and exits powerful score; captured 15 of 51 starts. SPEEDY BOLT – Decent showing behind frequent winner and pair of upset scores earlier. B B BAD – Advanced behind huge favorite after claim but on 11 race losing streak; needs best. Race 9 COLONEL BOB - Failed on turf and in Grade I event after impressive debut here; promising field. DREAM TALK – Pulled away despite drifting out badly in stretch when trying blinkers; threat. RIGHT WING RUNNER – Wore down determined opponent in very encouraging September bow. MISSION FIRST – Chased undefeated 2-5 chalk in Presque Isle stake; won debut at Monmouth. Race 10 TAP IN FORMATION – Weakened late after extended duel and well-suited at this distance.
