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Best E	Bets: SUNNY SIDE UP (2 nd) HARP'S HOT CORNER (8 th)
Race 1	
3	TIME TESTED – Less than one length behind despite early trouble and wide rally when claimed
1	FOUR EYES – Gained behind pair of next-out winners first local try; blinkers on in 17 th attempt.
5	ROSSINGTON – Second best behind runaway newcomer this spot; frequently hits board.
8	MARINE PATROL – Progressed last pair and stumbled at start behind third selection.
Race 2	
5	SUNNY SIDE UP – Used up chasing smashing repeat winner in tougher spot; double-digit romp.
3	CHANCE OCCURRENCE – Weakened after forcing pace in classier spot; speed to pose threat.
6	DUELA DENT – Led under pressure then faltered in better company; stamina issues persist.
1	LOVE LIKE CRAZY – Prominent final furlong in route and likely better suited this distance.
Race 3	
4	SUMMERSATTHESHORE – Crushed two-time winners able to control pace; same scenario likely
6	COVER THE SPREAD – Far behind in Laurel finale but major drop by leading barn dangerous.
2	DOROTHY'S THE BOSS – Upset slightly easier with favorable pace set-up; can't ignore this time.
5	AMALFI LADY – Fair showings against similar and surprised once in June; merits second look
Race 4	
7	AVES MAKIN' WAVES – Exits pair of solid efforts and faces soft opposition in 25 th try on bottom.
6	BOBO LIVER – Rookie obviously need not be much and worked :47 from gate here in October.
3	JAKNAVA – Closer than odds predicted last pair and hit board just twice in 18 outings.
2	STOUTHEARTED – Quick from gate but sidelined since May of last year; likely needs this.
Race	5
2	BUCKS SOME – Nine-year-old mare with \$399,795 in bank been idle but can handle this bunch.
3	BURNING EMBERS – Seen better days but drops again and should make presence felt early.
5	AKNA – Reluctant loading then faltered after pressing pace against three-time winners.
4	GIA'S FUEGO – Regained early foot in last but conqueror fared poorly in next; must shake loose.
Race 6	
1	COJELO PA TI – Heavily-backed with excuses in both defeats and blinkers likely to help.
7	AIRMAN TREVOR – Good effort against capable opponent on wet surface at Penn National.
5	HOLY MITOLE – Soundly beaten by second choice but only prior try encouraging; new pilot.
2	IL ROSSO – Newcomer reveals little in workouts; sire Cupid captured 5 stakes and \$1.7 million.

GRAHMALAMADINGDONG – Bargain claim placed first on pair of disqualifications; pace set-up. CARBONITE – Capable but bit erratic; figures close if disregard latest and Sanchez aboard. SLEIPNIR – Walloped easier switching to Tapsas barn and taking realistic next step. JAKE BRAKE ALLEY- Speedy gelding exits good try after claim by 25% Irving Rodriguez stable. Race 8 HARP'S HOT CORNER – Pulled away eagerly after dueling quick rival half mile after Ness claim. I FEELUCKY TONITE – Easily second best vs. heavily-favored repeat winner; barn heating up. CURLINS CRUZIN – Improved last pair and second finisher from latest romped next time. MASK PATROL – Numerous good efforts with solid opposition; scored after layoff earlier. Race 9 JOB'S NOT FINISHED – Made up ground sprinting and should be prepared for rare route try. ONTHISHARVESTMOON – Forced pace to midstretch as longshot in sprint; adds to lively pace. SENSIBLE MARRIAGE – Competed primarily over synthetic at Presque Isle; outrun locally past.

LUCKY OPPORTUNITY - Soundly outrun by top pick and stamina woes continue; might get part.
