Best Bets: ADERO (6<sup>th</sup>) -- COURBE (8<sup>th</sup>)

## Race 1

- PRETTY LILY Dueled this far in turf route after hiatus and just missed earlier at Turfway.
- 12 NORHO'S GAMBLE Step forward when chasing runaway winner; conqueror repeated.
- GAJA RAY Flashed speed then stopped badly but taking top to bottom plunge as threat.
- 4 MISS DIZ Offered little at Gulfstream but gets blinkers for new management as possibility.

## Race 2

- OMAHA EIGHT Failed to give true measure in Delaware mud after strong maiden score here.
- ROAD CALL Advanced behind smashing winner in June; good form here during winter.
- YOUBETTERBEJOKING Absent nearly four months since taken for higher tag in New York.
- CHINESEIAM Wired easier at Penn National after layoff when adding Lasix; fits well again.

## Race 3 THE \$75,000 SALVATORE M. DeBUNDA SPRINT

- MAXIMUS MERIDIUS Recent losses on turf and Grade I stake; first time gelding loves track.
- SUNNY BREEZE Undefeated in three attempts elsewhere; obvious danger for Allard barn.
- PRACTICALLY DARK Improving gelding won last pair at Gulfstream for leading Florida barn.
- BUCCHERINO Excellent speed inside and captured both local tries; impressed here in March.

# Race 4 THE \$100,000 PARX DASH

- GROOMS ALL BIZNESS Amazingly talented and consistent turf sprinter unlucky in local loss.
- THAT'S RIGHT Nearly wired Monmouth stake after \$40,000 claim by Russell; won Turf Monster.
- BOAT'S A ROCKIN Veteran grass sprinter with terrific 13-for-29 mark on turf; exits Va. victory.
- ALOGON Faced quality company lately and beaten favorite this event last year; can do better.

#### Race 5

- 5 SOUTHAMPTON DOCK Rallied strongly vs. repeat winner; just over five lengths back in stake.
- 4 LULLABY LAND Outrun in tougher company in New York; should regain closing kick this spot.
- **2** CORINNA Fired twice since layoff and battled capable state-breds at Penn National for Matz.
- CENTER STAGE Changed barns for \$40,000 and Kentucky invaders excelling locally.

# Race 6 THE \$75,000 MAYOR'S MILE

- ADERO Game gelding pulled away after early pressure in best yet; much success with Adorno.
- FILM STAR Trounced compact group at Saratoga; speedy runner-up in Woodward last year.
- 5 AMITY ROAD Making progress in Soto-Martinez barn and exits confidence booster at Penn.
- SEVEN'S ELEVEN May have needed sprint in first race since February; many wide margin wins

# Race 7 THE \$75,000 STATE REPRESENTATIVE'S SPRINT TWISTED RIDE – Much closer than odds predicted in Grade I at Spa; ample fight and ability. RECRUITER - Crushed Jersey rivals in second race after layoff; won half of 12 attempts. SCARAMOUCHE – Ended long losing skid as driving winner at Delaware; won Gallant Bob here. ALPINE THUNDER - Developing rapidly for Padilla-Preciado barn and seeks third straight. Race 8 THE \$200,000 CATHRYN SOPHIA STAKES COURBE - Gained late behind stablemate in one turn race after layoff; further progress likely. GUN SONG - Sharp in Monmouth Oaks after overmatched in Acorn; big speed along inside. IMPEL - Competed well in every outing including three consecutive graded stakes; dangerous. BAND OF GOLD – Hampered by traffic problems when just one length behind in Indiana Oaks. Race 9 THE \$200,000 SMARTY JONES STAKES GOULD'S GOLD - Overmatched when facing top of class at Spa; fired at various venues. CATALYTIC – Edged in sprint prep at Gulfstream and ignore poor Derby try; should improve. UNCLE HEAVY – Victim of poor start in Ohio; gets blinkers and severe excuse only local loss. JUST STEP ON IT - Prompted pace long way in Haskell after determined effort in local score. Race 10 NAVY RULES – Survived prolonged pressure then edged away on road trip; capable of repeat. TAP IN FORMATION – Returns to main track with significant drop; faces several front-runners. BIG JOHN - Overmatched at Monmouth after claimed in three prior starts; likely gaining lare. PEACH NECTAR - Romped twice at Delaware then idle over two months; threat with Lopez. Race 13 SARATOGA – THE \$1,250,000 TRAVERS STAKES

SIERRA LEONE – Several eventful trips but never lost by little more than one length; pace set-up
THORPEDO ANNA – Terrific filly captured 6 of 7 outings by combined 36 ¼ lengths; faces colts.

FIERCENESS – Prone to excuse but massive colt with loads of ability; beat top one Jim Dandy.

DORNOCH – Rapid colt seeks third straight Grade I score; survived early pressure in past.
