5	JACOHARE – Retreated in Jersey route but fired this level and yardage locally after layoff.	
1	SHANGHAI SUPERFLY – Capable in past with 7-for-36 record here and signs of life lately.	
8	BAD GUY – Overmatched on turf but prior try encouraging; chance with soft opposition.	
6	CAPTAIN CHAZZ – Probable pacesetter but hampered by stamina issues; hot apprentice up.

4	GRYPHON'S WINGS – Rallied behind runaway streaking winner and handled route before.	
6	LIAM'S KISS – Easily second best this spot and flattered when conqueror scored again.	
2	CULPA BLANCO – Claimed from three of last four outings; romped in May vs. single winners.	
3	KESTENNA – Slow fuse but often hits board and close as major longshot here in April.

5	SEPARATE WAYS – Drops in third race after layoff and seems able to wire this kind for DeMasi.	
3	WHY STOP THERE – Often quick early and distant third in better version this spot; key threat.	
1	STAR OF CAESAREA – Back sprinting at cheapest level yet; draws inside with Pennington.	
8	PACIFIC STATES – Numerous losses at short prices in 18 attempts but merits some attention.

6	TEXAS AIR FORCE – Couple good efforts in Florida and Gulfstream invaders excelling locally.	
8	MY BROTHER CHARLIE – Easily second best on road trip and conqueror just missed Saturday.	
4	WHOOSH – Dull with routers but rallied despite trouble this level and yardage earlier.	
1	MY BOY TULLIO – Gave up early when claimed but Padilla-Preciado barn clicking at 21% rate.

6	SEA TRIDENT – Frequently claimed veteran faded as 3-2 chalk but should end losing streak.	
5	HOLDTHEFLIGHT – Shown little since \$20,000 claim but can't dismiss against this kind.	
7	BIG BROWN SHOES – Weakened at Delaware as odds-on chalk after wiring Penn opposition.	
4	CADDY MAN – Trailed compact group on road trip but all three victories over this track.

1	PAPA LAPA – Heavily-backed but victim of eventful trip in debut; Reid barn with juvenile tigers.	
6	LIGHT THE WAY – Overmatched at Saratoga but often close at Aqueduct; speed to pose threat.	
2	PILOTE COMETE – Making progress and addition of blinkers helped; son of top sire Munnings.	
5	KHOOLZAN – Faltered in stretch at Delaware in return; fitter now and fired twice at Gulfstream.

8	MAKABIM – Advanced strongly this spot when Pino took; pair of wide margin scores earlier.	
5	SECRET PATH – Hard to like or ignore plunge after Ness claimed for \$15,000; obvious danger.	
4	ASSEMBLY POINT – Solid effort on occasion and back in Abrams barn with Lopez aboard.	
7	TEEWINOT PASS – Closed gap again in sprint and decisive score in earlier route; upset shot.

1	GIRVIN'S PRINCESS – Exits pair of stakes since hiatus and good form at Tampa; well-spotted.	
6	DREAM CHASER – Raced sparingly but ample ability and back in dirt sprint; back in for tag.	
8	I BELIEVE IN MAGIC – Pulled away from more numerous winners in Jersey return; fits nicely.	
7	FROSTED DIAMOND – Good effort against slightly softer company; must put it all together.

1	IT'S GAME TIME – Veteran takes aggressive drop seeking 16 <sup>th</sup> career score; speed along rail.	
8	KINGSVILLE – Seven race losing streak but 9-year-old threat this level; \$314,571 in bankroll.	
2	IRISH HONOR – Edged as longshot at Penn National and sharp drop in third race since return.	
6	GREENER PASTURES – Midwest invader often taken for much higher tags; several local works.
