Best Bets: GAJA RAY (1st) -- FLAMINGO WAY (8th)

Race 1

- GAJA RAY Impressive romp when taking top to bottom plunge; new stable avoids claim tag.
- NAMORA Broke very poorly then advanced behind stablemate last week; needs alert start.
- UNION BELLE Fired both local tries and from leading barn at Penn National; steady progress.
 - KOKOPELLI GIRL Realistic drop after disappointing effort; speed to pose threat this level.

Race 2

- ANGELIC STORM Cruised past two-time winners and should repeat with logical next step.
- DISCO DAISY Decisive score with easier at Penn National but lost all five local outings.
- AKNA Chased streaking winner after Diaz claim and threat if puts it all together.
- BOHEMIA BABE Quick early but hampered by stamina woes; posted 31-1 shocker earlier.

Race 3

- BAHAMA PEARL Speedy mare crushed slightly softer last week; capable of repeating.
- MATTY BO Overmatched in last and likely to force pace this level; often forms part of exacta.
- CAPTIVATING CARA Disliked wet footing as always; showed she fits with these previously.
- LEAN ON E Veteran won this spot in May and changed from front-runner to closer; 10 wins.

Race 4

- WISHING ONA PRAYER Improving filly captured third of 18 starts; steps up, retains Hernandez
- EXPECT TO BE READY Weakened late under severe pressure; racing into shape again.
- FAIRY DREAMS Overmatched on road trips and defeated similar locally; gives game effort.
- CABRA CHICA Soundly beaten when claimed after hiatus but often formidable in past.

Race 5

- BATTALIA Led throughout in three straight dominating scores and handles another raise.
- CONFIRMED GENIUS Absent three months but veteran with 10 victories and \$342,976 bankroll.
- AEGEAN SEA Front-runner victim of early roughing in Jersey; effective when reaches front.
- FAST MOTION Trounced lesser again and changed hands; retains Rivera with outside speed.

Race 6

- PEOPLE FORCE Back on dirt where he was just over 4 lengths back at Spa; won pair in Fla.
- THE KING CHEEK Bit difficult to guess but handles various surfaces and likely speed inside.
- SPEIGHTSTER RED Drops notch and much success in Lupe Guerrero barn; determined threat.
- YOU MUST CHILL Veteran tigerish here in past and fired at various venues this season.

Race 7 2 URBAN SYMPHONY – By great Curlin (\$10 million) and dam raced strongly in numerous stakes. RIGHT WING RUNNER – Sire won Woodward and Suburban and this colt \$75,000 auction buy. BEYONDEXPECTATIONS - Half-brother to stakes winner Uncle Heavy; Reid barn full of tigers. POSSUM – Early excuse in debut at Timonium and trains locally; outside post might help. Race 8 FLAMINGO WAY – Big effort in bulky field when nearly overcoming traffic woes; has impressed. JEZEBEL JADE – May have needed first outing in three months; extra yardage proves helpful. KINDRED HEARTS – Overran capable routers when trying blinkers; stablemate of top pick. SEEYOUATTHEHOP – Edged away after dueling last week in "open" company; tested here. Race 9 2 MAJESTIC CREED - Bothered early in classy field last week; ample past success with Sanchez. REGALED – Stretch-runner yet to handle older rivals but competed in pair of graded stakes. DANCING ON MY OWN - Bargain claim won recently at Delaware; Dunn barn clicking at 33%. GOLD MEDAL ANNA – Failed to give true measure on road trip; sharp this spot locally in May. Race 10 BAAFEED – Significant drop exiting field from which several entrants ran big next time. FAST BOB – Difficult to like or dismiss plunge after voided claim for \$15,000; closing punch.

COMMANDER CARL – Tired after layoff at Ellis but shows three decisive scores in Kentucky.

SEA TRIDENT – Trounced cheaper to end losing skid and claimed again; renewed confidence.
