Best Bets: CURLINS CRUZIN (6th) -- HORNBEAM (9th)

- **2** ZOPPI FISCHBEIN Exits better version this spot; re-claimed earlier by Mosco and should rally
- 8 SURFBOARD Yet to justify heavy backing here and Laurel but Ness runner threat on best.
- FREE BIRD BORDO Absent two months and stretching out again; likely prefers this yardage.
- I'M NOT A BABY Gave up early in latest but prior outing makes threat for hot Gallimore barn.

Race 2

- CHANCE OCCURRENCE Dueled this far around two turns on turf; quick but makes 13th try.
- MISSUPTOWNTOODELOU Responded well at loftier level after claim; back down claim ladder.
- ROYAL UPSTART Switches from turf route to dirt sprint; hit board there prior main track tries.
- MELODY'S KISS Far behind on turf after hiatus but can't dismiss yet at this level.

Race 3

- SALAGADOOLA Cruised past quicker field when Lake re-claimed; plunges and retains Lopez.
- BEYOND A MILLION Full of run too late this spot when easily second best; needs pace set-up.
- 8 CAPTIVATING STAR Advanced sprinting again and should be prepared for two turns.
- 5 SCOTT ALAIA Absent well over two months since poor showing but formidable on best.

Race 4

- 2 CHARLIZE CHUB Capable in past and takes realistic drop after overmatched twice in Jersey.
- 8 KHOZY COLBY Shipper changed management again; part of exacta in half of 14 outings.
- BAY BAY BIRDIE Drops after poor showing in sloppy route; prior try stamps threat.
- CORONA CAMPIONE Hard-earned score when claimed; remains eligible as three-year-old.

Race 5

- ANGELIC STORM Not much last pair but formidable at times and softer route fractions plus.
- FAR HEART Likely ability advantage but sidelined over year and might need this.
- GRYPHON'S WINGS Forced pace for three quarters before fading following claim for more.
- 8 AUNT BERRA Rare attempt around two turns in second try for Smith barn; upset possibility.

Race 6

- CURLINS CRUZIN Dominated lesser from start in impressive score and should handle raise.
- JACKSON ROAD Chased runaway winner at Delaware; sharp return outing locally this spot.
- TRUMPET CALL Nosed by heavy favorite in best yet and used up early in prior route try.
- **8** TOP OF THE STREET Good enough to win earlier at Keeneland and back in sprint; gains late.

Race 7 2 EMILY'S ON FIRE – Led throughout defeating heavily-backed newcomer; seems well-spotted. UNION BELLE - Improved effort against repeat winner; pair of strong races for Kreiser barn. KOKOPELLI GIRL – Used up dueling rival capturing second straight decisive score; fits nicely. DIANE'S MERLOT – Series of losses against decisive winners but proven she fits this spot. Race 8 HIPPY HIPPY SHAKE – Sire won 2019 Breeders' Cup Sprint; Preciado barn won pair recently. MAXIMUS ANGELICUS – Regally-bred filly competed well but failed at odds-on in bow; threat. NOT TOO LATE – Sire McKinzie won Pennsylvania Derby and over \$3 million; flying here in a.m. CENTRAL TO SUCCESS – Worked best of 28 from gate at half mile; sire excels in New York. Race 9 HORNBEAM – Easily second best behind impressive winner; conqueror jumped up and repeated VISUAL ARTIST – Exits sharp effort when easily second best at Delaware; on rare losing streak. SECRET ALLIANCE – Dueled and weakened in tough version this spot; good form with Haddock HEY PORTER – Overmatched on road trip after pair of solid tries here; Castillo barn been firing. Race 10 REAL TALK – Strong recent try in Jersey despite poor start; ends losing skid as lone speed. MEET ME AT MUNDIS – Hard-hitter claimed last month by Ness for \$40,000; late kick likely. GEEBERT – Eight-year-old with 13 victories and retains finishing kick; extra yardage a plus. B B BAD – Stretch-runner kept talented opposition lately; often better than odds predict. Race 11 GREAT NAVIGATOR - Failed as huge favorite in Jersey route; likely better suited this yardage.

Race 12

8 MIDNIGHT ACT – Seen better days but plunges to bottom and sheds 10 pounds; \$356,997 bank.

THE JUDGE AND JURY – Road warrior fits well this spot and local success in past; lures Lopez. SPEEDY BOLT – Surprised similar with perfect trip behind dueling pacesetters; needs set-up.

- 12 GABE Weakened late as 6-5 chalk in sprint but probable pacesetter with slower fractions.
- FLAT LUCKY Classy veteran humbled by runaway winner at Delaware; racing into shape.
- MUCHO MACHO EDDIE Dueled long way before yielding to smashing winner; obvious threat.
