

#### Celebrating Racing and Aftercare

Gone are the days when breeders and racehorse owners were at odds with horse rescuers and Sporthorse riders. Horseracing has embraced Aftercare wholeheartedly. While the PTHA's Turning for Home, Inc. (TFH) was the first retired racehorse program at a year-round track, now each horse is afforded the opportunity at every track. The 2024 Triple Crown races boast record betting numbers, and more and more people support Thoroughbreds, both on and off the track, proof that the divide is closing and horseracing has found a path that protects it into the next century.

At the halfway mark of 2024, TFH assisted 147 individual horses with safe retirement as part of our ongoing mission to protect Parx Racing's retired horses and assist as needed the ones who need help finding a safe second career. With the addition of program assistant Sam Potts working to reach out to our alums, we can tune into the TFH Socials and see our former horses successful in their third, fourth, or tenth discipline in their teenage years as they find adopters who appreciate the Thoroughbred in all its facets. An umbrella of protection that follows the horses as they are rehabilitated, retrained, and rehomed, our team carefully follows their journeys. Promoting the Thoroughbred as the versatile sporthorses we know they are is so important we have partnered with Second Call to showcase these horses in a huge show and adopt-a-thon on November 2nd. (www.allthoroughbredshowdown.org) Horseracing is doing all the right things to protect its horses while racing and after, and the public needs to know!

at Parx, where more people can meet racing owners,

Life is a fascinating trip. You never know where it will lead you. With periods of highs and lows, twists and turns, you may encounter life-changing experiences. Jackie Gordon, who was struggling with addiction, knocked on the door of a church, unaware that the little elderly lady who opened it would alter her life. The woman requested a hug, but Jackie declined, embarrassed by her untidy and dirty hair. With loving words, the Deacon said, "Everyone deserves a hug." Jackie awoke on August 15th and asked the Lord to take away her addiction, and she went into recovery, never looking back.

Soon, she was driving an 18-wheeler truck for Fed Ex and eventually teaching other women how to do the same. She wanted to provide a safe space for women to learn without being intimidated or harassed in the workplace. After driving for 38 years, she retired in 2012 and launched Miss Gordon's Water Ice in Northeast Philadelphia. Because the apartments are close to a highway, she wanted to provide an area for the children to safely get snacks during the summer while they enjoyed the pool. She gives back to her community in a variety of ways, including gathering the children and parents at the start of the season to pray for a safe summer, handing out school backpacks, providing Thanksgiving meals to numerous families, and giving each child a toy at Christmas. Because it is only open during the summer, Jackie needed to find something to do the rest of the year. Her neighbor across the street, Manuel Rosario, wanted to know if she knew someone who might like to walk horses at Parx, so Jackie took a chance and filled out an application

Jackie, who is approaching her sixteenth year in the Parx backstretch community, started working for Mike Pino as a hotwalker, and her very first horse reared up startling her. His assistant at the time told her, "Girl, you drove an 18-wheeler; all that steel you're pushing. Think of the horse as the truck you've been driving." Suddenly, everything clicked, and she was no longer frightened. After hurting her foot and requiring surgery, she was unable to walk horses. They wanted to keep her on as an employee, so she changed responsibilities and began assisting with the logistics of the business. Pino gave her the nickname "Get er done girl" because he knows she can manage things and get them done, such as keeping track of the horses' paperwork, hiring new employees, delivering payroll, and ensuring they have all of their supplies in the barn.

She proudly declared that she has been attending church every Sunday at the Enon Tabernacle Baptist Church for the last 30 years. After graduating from her Evangelism program six years ago, she opted to further her education and is currently pursuing an Associate's and eventually a Bachelor's degree in Evangelism. Her passion is to serve others: "I do what I have to do to help somebody. It's in my heart to help others. I go where God needs me."
