Memo from PTHA President ROBERT HUTT

As President of the PTHA I'm proud to announce that effective immediately your "earned purse funds" are available the following week on Thursday at the Horsemen's Bookkeepers office without having to wait for drug testing to be completed. This means if you earn purses Monday, Tuesday, or Wednesday, you can pick up your check the following week on Thursday.

To take advantage of this "release of funds" please visit the PTHA office on the backstretch and complete the notarized waiver form. If you can't make it to the office, you can request the "waiver form" by phone or email. Once you receive it, please get it notarized; however, you must mail back the original notarized form to the PTHA office. No emails, PDF's or faxes will be accepted.

In other news, as PTHA President I met with HISA in Florida at the THA consortium. I explained to HISA that by taking horses who are creatures of habit, out of their normal "race day" routine, it is causing a great disturbance. Making horses walk to the test barn for TCO2 testing (milkshakes), creates an unfair playing field for that race. Many trainers were upset and had been complaining about this invasive practice. The good news is that HISA, along with the Pennsylvania Racing Commission listened, and have agreed to abolish this practice as the random TCO2 test will now occur at your barn!



One more very important thing about random TCO2 testing. Please remember that the trainer at the time of the test has the ability to ask the vets to pull an additional sample, to have as a split. In Pennsylvania as of this writing I know of 9 positives between Penn National and PARX which seems exceedingly high. Your PTHA Board is already looking into this. Until next time wishing you many winners!

Update from Executive Director JEFFREY A. MATTY, JR.

HORSEMEN:

As we spring through April, many things PTHA-related are on the horizon. The Triple Crown is next month, and a few Parx horses are nominated to the Derby and or Oaks. We will all be rooting should they make the starting gate the first week of May.

Our purse release program is well underway. Providing horsemen their purse money in an 8–10-day window is what everyone felt was acceptable, and ultimately what we could deliver on.

Continuing collaboration between the PTHA and Pennsylvania Horse Racing Commission has led to TCO2 testing no longer being done in the test barn, instead, the tests will be done in the horse's stall. I thank Tom Chuckas and Ismael Navarreto of the PHRC for assisting with this request.

With warmer weather comes our first

batch of weekend racing. We will be running LIVE all Triple Crown Saturdays, as well as Father's Day Sunday, Mark Your Calendars!



The PTHA continues to organize and form committees to better assist in our ongoing projects here. Please stop in the office to sign up for a spot or suggest a needed committee.

Trainers – As you start to think about the Parx Summer Break – The Track WILL BE CLOSED FOR TRAINING – from Sunday, July 28th to Sunday, August 4th (Weather Depending), Re-Opening Monday, August 5th.

PARX RACING HELD THE FIRST STAKES RACES OF THE 2024 YEAR WITH THE \$75,000 MAIN LINE STAKES AND THE \$75,000 CITY OF BROTHERLY LOVE STAKES FOR 3-YEAR-OLDS ON 3/5/24.

Trainer Butch Reid, Jr. finished an impressive first and second in the \$75,000 Main Line Stakes with PA Bred filly Jeanne Marie getting the win with jockey Mychel Sanchez for owners/breeders Cash Is King LLC and LC Racing LLC and stablemate Kiss For Luck and jockey Abner Adorno finishing second for owner/breeder Swilcan Stable LLC.

Trainer Hugo Padilla got his first stakes win in the \$75,000 City Of Brotherly Love Stakes with the Washington Bred bay colt Lonesome Boy with jockey Adam Bowman riding for owner John Parker going 1 mile and 70 yards.

On 3/02/24 Carmelina ran 2nd at Aqueduct in the \$200,000 Busher Stakes with jockey Mychel Sanchez riding for trainer Butch Reid, Jr., owners Cash Is King LLC and LC Racing LLC.

The super cool Sevier takes it all in stride with career win #30 with jockey Frankie Pennington riding for trainer Jamie Ness, owners Morris Kernan, Jr., Yo Berbs & Jagger Inc after a victory at Parx Racing in Tuesday's 6th race on 3/12/24.

On 3/18/24 Trainer Tyler Servis had a 2 win day with 2 grays - Dream Big Dreams & jockey Frankie Pennington getting a win for owner Cash Is King LLC & LC Racing LLC in the 1st race and Gray Lightning for owner/breeder Wynter Racing Stable with jockey Jorge Vargas, Jr. pulling away from the field in the 6th race.

Hall Of Fame Trainer John Servis won 4 races between 3/18/24 & 3/19/24 with jockey Frankie Pennington riding Uncle Ernie to win for owner/breeder Gilman Hallenbeck and Pachelbel for owner/breeder Newell Thoroughbreds. Jockey Abner Adorno rode Adero for owner Carguys Racing LLC and Corona Campione for owner Crown Stable.

Counterspy has been on a roll getting 2 impressive wins on 3/4/24 & 3/20/24 for connections Trainer Bobby Mosco and owner Jack Armstrong both with jockey Mychel Sanchez riding this promising 4-year-old by sire Gun Runner.

The 9-year-old mare Flashdynamite won twice for trainer Trevor Gallimore & owner Candy's Racing Stable with jockey Silvestre Gonazlez riding her to the victories on 3/12/24 & 3/20/24.

SAFE HAVEN FOR HORSES

From the desk of the Program Administrator Danielle Montgomery

The goal for our retirement program at Parx Racing over the last 15 years has been to safely transition retiring Parx racehorses to dependable, well-vetted, and experienced Partner Farms who will give them every opportunity to find a home to carry on over the next twenty years of their potential lifespan. It's an arduous task to bring in an athlete who needs tender-loving care, often without knowing (horses don't speak English) a full history and using experience and horsemanship to figure out what those needs are. at the top of the list of experienced professions is Kate Goldenberg of Safe Haven Eqine in Perkasie, PA.

Some of the big, pretty on-the-outside farms look right, but there is so much more involved in transitioning and finding homes for these horses than a pretty paddock. Just like the Dan + Shay song lyrics,

"The thing about happiness

I've found is

It don't live in bigger houses.",

Kate Goldenberg from Safe Haven Thoroughbred Rescue, Inc. brought Rico, a baby lamb, to the Norristown, Early Learning Academy this week. The children got to pet, bottle feed, and learn about all kinds of different farm animals. Using real sheep wool (shh, don't tell Rico), the students even had the opportunity to create their own sheep farm.

While we have always searched for where to set up outreach, we never considered when we should share our message. How better to influence the continued love for horses than to share them at the earliest times, in preschool. Headstart teacher April Winco combined her volunteer work at Safe Haven Equine, with early education. And what is more exciting to children than farm animals? Bringing the descriptive videos into the classroom of TFH's Mouse, retired by Pam Shavelson for a bowed tendon, inspired lessons in being respectful, responsible, and safe using Mouse as an example.

"Animals bring out the best in most of us," Kate Goldenberg admits and shared photos with the students of the recovering Wispering Springs, who had a tumor removed from his jaw with assistance from TFH and surgery at Mid-Atlantic Equine. This inspired toddlers to feed and wrap their stuffed horses in the classroom, perhaps inspiring a future veterinarian.

Retired racehorses started the fun, and Kate and April went on to bring a lamb into the classroom. Rumor is that a pony foal may appear in the future for these young veterinarians. We think they are on to something great and would love to help more of our Thoroughbreds become teacher's pets!


