Best Bets: SECRET PATH (4<sup>th</sup>) -- ICONIC LEGACY (8<sup>th</sup>)

**4** PRINCE COLTON – Determined score in recent outing and perfect locally around two turns.

**1** CHECK MY SIX – Failed turf experiment but strong prior form on main track as threat.

**2** DANCE A DINI – Returns to preferred surface where he won decisively last month; fits well.

**9** THE GATEKEEPER – Rediscovered speed and ability when responding nicely to plunge.

#### Race 2

**3** SHACKLEFORD COUNTY – Rallied strongly behind favored winner after layoff; can progress.

**2** SENSE A MILLION – Advanced late behind top choice and another 10-time winner during career.

**1** LIPLOCK – Signs of interest lately on turf and dirt and sheds five pounds as possibility.

**4** SHE'S GOT GAME – Probable pacesetter hampered by stamina issues; needs to shake loose.

#### Race 3

**4** EDGE OF GLORY – Weakened as huge favorite when dropping again; facing soft opposition.

**1** MAJOR CAM – Narrowed big gap when finishing ahead of top pick; needs alert break from rail.

**6** MISTER MOORE – Hard used dueling again in sprint and likely pacesetter with softer fractions.

**8** CARNIVORE – Numerous losses at short odds but showed ability in past; can't dismiss yet.

#### Race 4

**3** SECRET PATH – Determined try against streaking winner when claimed from this spot; Lopez up

**5** PIT BOSS – Rebounded from poor showing with 26-1 surprise following claim by Arce barn.

**2** ROMAN EMPIRE – Crushed easier in strongest outing in ages; chance despite major jump.

**7** SHERIFF RONNIE – Four-time winner this year idle couple months since dull effort in mud.

#### Race 5

**1** VITAEMI – Looked bit like old self when battling throughout last; 9-year-old with 13 victories.

**8** LEAN ON E – Veteran altered usual running style and closed well in recent races; key threat.

**10** PEYTON'S COLLEGE – Seeks third straight score with Martinez up; realistic next step.

**3** MATTY BO – Speedy filly dueled to final yards with similar when claimed; softens front-runners.

#### Race 6

**1** SCAMP WALKER – Competed well despite breaking poorly again; Padilla-Preciado barn firing.

**5** MY MAN WOODY – Finished one length in front of top choice with better trip; romped in April.

**3** CHECKING BOXES – Drops after weakening in stretch again; needs to reach front early.

**7** MILAGROSO – Likely to be gaining late but lone victory from 27 tries; some progress needed.

**Race 7**

<b>2</b>	<b>LOVE TO EAT</b> – Set pace before humbled by favored Oaklawn invader; shorter yardage a plus.
<b>4</b>	<b>TEMPEST RISING</b> – Good form since Mosco claim and finished just over length behind top pick.
<b>7</b>	<b>FROSTED DIAMOND</b> – Roughed early with similar and prior two races encouraging; hot rider.
<b>5</b>	<b>PRINCESS CUPID</b> – Gave up early when overmatched in comeback; speedy and logical drop.

**Race 8**

<b>8</b>	<b>ICONIC LEGACY</b> – Trounced lesser in impressive style when Lake claimed; can handle raise.
<b>9</b>	<b>EGO MAN</b> – Very game effort when edged by pair of closers after battling throughout this spot.
<b>1</b>	<b>FAST BOB</b> – Veteran stretch-runner closed strongly when rebounding from poor try; dangerous.
<b>6</b>	<b>JW'STRICKYMISCHIEF</b> – Controlled early and battled when collared; just 4-for-66 lifetime.

**Race 9**

<b>9</b>	<b>FIRE PIT</b> – Chased heavily-favored experienced rival when easily second best in Laurel debut.
<b>10</b>	<b>CHILL BOSS</b> – Half-brother won and placed in numerous stakes; sire gets some quick ones.
<b>7</b>	<b>THE TIRE MAN</b> – Remote third in bow but should benefit from experience vs. many rookies.
<b>4</b>	<b>ANALOG JONES</b> – Working quickly over track and sire finished first, DQ'd in Kentucky Derby.

**Race 10**

<b>3</b>	<b>YESTERNIGHT</b> – Dueled long way in talented and bulky field after layoff at Churchill; fired locally
<b>4</b>	<b>AOIFE'S MAGIC</b> – Unlucky on turf and prior try possibly best yet; Parx Horse of Year gets Lasix.
<b>6</b>	<b>MIA TOSCA</b> – Shown talent and versatility winning long and short recently; quick return to claim.
<b>5</b>	<b>BENEATH THE STARS</b> – Absent nearly three months since Ness took for \$40,000; back on dirt.

**Race 11**

<b>8</b>	<b>ADERO</b> – Dueled odds-on winner to late yards and prior loss in graded stake; capable and game
<b>5</b>	<b>BESTSUGARDADDYEVER</b> – Romped at Laurel after outrun by top pick locally; 6-for-13 lifetime.
<b>7</b>	<b>WINDSOR GOLD</b> – Big effort after shoe repair when Moore took for \$40,000; retains Wolfsont.
<b>4</b>	<b>IRISH CORK</b> – Failed to solid stake on road trip but back on Lasix and much success locally.

**Race 12**

<b>4</b>	<b>DALTON</b> – Set up well for elongated sprint when prominent long way in route; drops after claim.
<b>3</b>	<b>DIXIE'S TWO STENTS</b> – Slow fuse but significant drop competing cheapest ever; lures Lopez.
<b>11</b>	<b>RUNYONESQUE</b> – Versatile lately but exits series of frustrating losses at this level for Guerrero.
<b>1</b>	<b>CONNECTING</b> – Keeps firing and trounced two-time winners with perfect trip; yardage suits.
