Best Bets: FAST BOB (7th) -- SUNDAY SPIRIT (8th)

- NAMORA- Aggressive drop after \$16,000 claim earlier; ends loss streak for Ness-Sanchez combo
- TREASURE PEACE Hard used dueling drop-down winner; speed along inside plus lately.
- SWANS ISLAND Switches turf to dirt and flashes of interest earlier; contributes to quick pace.
- JAVA'S LUCKY LADY Battled all way in narrow loss at Penn National; third race since return.

Race 2

- LA TACHE Upset big favorite in Delaware finale and Sillaman barn excelling with shippers.
- 5 LIAM'S KISS Game mare fired six straight but failed at 3-5 this spot; obvious threat again.
- 2 AMALFI LADY Progressed in recent outings, finishing less than one length behind second pick
- 4 CONNELMAURA Back stretching out again on main track; chance to end long losing skid.

Race 3

- VILLANITO Drops after chasing smashing winner in second race after hiatus; can handle these
- 5 KHOPESH Narrowed gap behind top choice and edged this spot earlier; late kick anticipated.
- BEAN MACHINE Competed exclusively on turf and synthetic but racing cheapest ever.
- RUN CORY RUN Prominent throughout when claimed from first local start; merits attention.

Race 4

- CATTI LA BELLE Overcame traffic problems to capture sprint after Wyner barn re-claimed.
- **5** BUNNY BONUS Raced well but lacked early zip displayed in past; must put it all together.
- CREATIVE COPY Ample heart and ability but raced only once since April when Hernandez won
- HAPPY UNION Outran sprinters in decisive style and pushed top pick to limit prior outing.

Race 5

- **ZOPPI FISCHBEIN** Closed gap behind better company in sprint and bevy of early targets a plus
- CHECKITUP Dueled then pulled away from softer rivals in confidence booster; threat again.
- PARKERNESS Speedy gelding possible pacesetter and hit board all four local tries; consider.
- 4 EDDIE W Edged top choice after setting pace in latest; rallied from far back earlier sprint.

Race 6

- | IT'S GAME TIME Dueled to stretch in typical game effort; 16 victories and might shake loose.
- 8 ROADTRIPTONOWHERE Formidable at times and drops notch seeking first score in over year.
- VINE JET Cruised past easier when claimed back by Perez barn; stalker nearly always fires.
- PREDOMINATE Improved after claim to edge heavy favorite; continues progress stepping up.

Race 7 9 FAST BOB – Looked like old self again sweeping past bulky field with perfect trip; should repeat. KATE'S GOLDEN DUDE – Nine-year-old lightly raced but rapid and amazing 16 career scores. HOTPOT – Stretch-runner frequently claimed and offers big closing kick; sat out "jail" for this. JUSTINSPEIGHTOFIT – Humbled by heavily-favored Ness runner at Delaware after winning twice Race 8 SUNDAY SPIRIT – Pair of nice efforts since arriving from Ky.; recent rival romped again in Md. ATROCIOUS – Competed well but overmatched in stake after racing on synthetic Presque Isle. TRICOLOUR – Stuck head in front at eighth pole then hung when runner-up for 13th time. IRISH WISH – Far back twice during summer but worked quickly since; respect Reid runners. Race 9 NINJA PRIZE – Dueled formidable rival throughout in game try when claimed for \$25,000. WINNING TIME – Rapid and talented runner raced very sparingly but fired after long layoff Jan. ALL AMERICAN ROD – Perfect both attempts as longshot; shelved since March but dangerous. BOLT OF AURUM – Battled to final furlong in solid Laurel field when adding Lasix; barn at 23%. Race 10 PRETTY LILY – Rallied nicely behind Ness barn winner in tougher version of this spot.

FAST GAL – Hard used dueling in longer test dominated by closers; obvious threat with Lopez.

JOB'S NOT FINISHED – Finished behind top pick after hiatus and might continue to improve.

THE GIRL'S NO JOKE – Drops notch and adds to likely contested pace; deserves second look.
