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Best Bets: BOYS OF SUMMER (4th) -- KEITHSENDSHELLOOOO

Race 1

- 2 HUMBLE JOE Significant drop seeking third victory and sufficient targets for late kick.
- 4 KHOPESH Rediscovered ability when edged by huge favorite last week; must put two together.
- GO EAST Solid effort this spot in second race after hiatus despite early roughing; fits well.
- SCAMP WALKER Lacks speed but offers late punch on occasion; rail post possible obstacle.

Race 2

- 8 ON PARADISE HILL Dueled in good effort against drop-down winner; making steady progress.
- STREETS OF PARIS Battled this far longer test for higher tag as 3-5 chalk; Guerrero barn hot.
- 3 SILVER CITY KITTY First foal out of unraced dam making debut for Ness; need not be much.
- YES MY LADY LINO Very quick but hampered by stamina issues; back at level of claim.

Race 3

- 2 DISTURBED Stretch-runner drops and improved in recent months; benefits from lively pace.
- UP AGAINST IT Solid effort when Pino claimed from this spot last month; 14 career victories.
- DATHOSS Numerous good tries during winter and lures Lopez for hot Abrams stable.
- ROCK ON LUKE Classy veteran seen better days and plunges; just one outing since summer.

Race 4

- BOYS OF SUMMER Fair Hill shipper finds ideal spot and won local debut impressively 2024.
- HEAT ALERT Very game in narrow loss this spot after romping when claimed by Flores-Coba.
- NIMMO Trounced weak maidens in 13th attempt but possibility with renewed confidence.
- 5 SPINNING HEART Lost photo this level as longshot and threat with similar showing.

Race 5

- SWANS ISLAND Led when easily second best this spot after Pino took; works out rail rally.
- HOLY KINGDOM Flashes of interest at Gulfstream and merits attention despite 1-for-19 mark.
- MIKEY'S SONG Significant drop after remote fourth and cost more than twice this amount.
- LOOKINGFORTREASURE Edged away from bottom maidens after layoff; logical next step.

Race 6

- 2 KEITHSENDSHELLOOOO Closed gap despite traffic problems after Ness claim; duel can help.
- FINAL SHOT Eliminated by stumbling break in January; 10-year-old nearing half million in bank
- ENFORCER Hard-hitter fired this level after Padilla claim; scored as 8-1 bargain previously.
- MAGICNTHEMOONLIGHT Terrific on best but tends to weaken in stretch lately; must respect.

Race 7 GUAPONESS – Pressured throughout by repeat winner in game try; set to end losing streak. REMARKABLE MO – Victim of loose pacesetter after early trouble; won three in row earlier. UNION LIGHTS – Less than two lengths behind after poor start at Aqueduct; moves to Ness barn WHAT A BLAST – Decisive score with two-time winners when dropping; figures close again. Race 8 FOUR EYES – May have needed first outing in two months after crushing maidens in November. AMAZING WOO – Numerous strong tries at Gulfstream; encouraging raise for new management. STAY FUNNY – Speedy gelding with clear lead and extra sixteenth mile; usually hits board. 3 STARLORD – Fair showing taking plunge last week when Lake claimed; obvious contender. Race 9 OFFALY COOL – Sharp effort in Laurel stake and terrific 5-for-7 locally; rail and back on Lasix. ADERO – Lightly raced but loads of heart and ability; stakes-winner here in compact field. FAR MO POWER – Improved speed in quick field in second race after layoff; formidable on best. TREBLE CLEF - Ended losing skid in quality field at Penn National; tested again with this kind. Race 10

GOLDIENESS – Held on nicely despite constant pressure; third outing since return for hot barn. MENDED WE STAND – Just ahead of top choice when re-claimed soon as possible; dangerous. QUEEN CADENCE – Absent over three months and difficult to like or ignore plunge. BUCKS SOME – Ten-year-old mare dull in last and making 77th start with \$408,511 in bankroll.
