

# CRAIG DONNELLY'S ANALYSIS @ parxracing



Craig has been involved in horseracing for 50+ years as a handicapper, journalist, linemaker and analyst. He began his career in 1969 handicapping the races for the Miami Beach Sun. Beginning in 1971 he began picking winners for the Philadelphia Inquirer, where he remained for 37 years. Craig has also been a linemaker for the Atlantic City Racecourse and The Meadowlands, where he was the program oddsmaker and television co-host for seven seasons.



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Best Bets: REAL CONVICTION (4th) – WESTERN WOMAN (8th)

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- **8** K D CAKES Sidelined since voided claim in May but sufficient ability and from top stable.
- LADY ANNABELLE Advanced late behind lively pace and third finisher won next easily.
- 2 SNOW LAKE Distant fourth on drop and much sharper earlier but chance with this kind.
- 4 MERRYCHILL Disappointing try in last but claimed from 4 of last 5 outings; must consider.

# Race 2

- TAKE TIME TO DREAM Another solid effort as heavy favorite; battled classy rival previously.
- 4 NO FAKE Fired every local outing and walloped two-time winners; retains Lopez as threat.
- BRIGHT KOHANA Speedy filly fits well but tends to weaken in late stages; extra yardage here.
- JAVA'S LUCKY LADY Chased runaway winner at Penn and should contribute to quick pace.

# Race 3

- ADDYSON'S DREAM Hard used pressing impressive Ness winner at Penn; third race of year.
- 5 SHORE TIME Faced state-breds at Aqueduct for higher tags; possibility with this kind.
- 4 ONE LAST KISS Led to final yards after arriving from Gulfstream; back up claiming ladder.
- **2** BAD ADVICE Faded after half mile in latest but Pino stable winning with third of starters.

# Race 4

- REAL CONVICTION Trounced solid field in route and finds perfect spot in elongated sprint.
- OKIE DEN DEN Dueled under severe pressure to late stages this spot; prior try excellent.
- BOTTLES Crushed easier adding Lasix in return; fitter now and danger despite step-up.
- SUPERNESS Possibility if throw out latest; capable but needs to put pair together.

#### Race 5

- PIT BOSS Edged by Ness barn drop-down when easily second best and claim again; nine wins.
- WINGED FOOT Just missed at Laurel after closing big gap locally; ample early targets a plus.
- TYCOON Distant third in possibly better version this spot; veteran terrific last season.
- 2 SUPREME SONG Shelved since September but speedy and successful on Ohio circuit.

# Race 6

- WYNN GIANT Rallied behind Ness re-claim with strong closing kick again; very wide prior try.
- SAILOR'S RETURN Finished well in sprint this level and most recent poor tries on wet tracks.
- AULA Far back against tougher last pair but double-digit romp earlier; difficult to guess.
- 8 INSPEIGHTOFTRAINER Overran two-time winners despite early trouble; up class down in tag.

# Race 7 2 SPEIGHTSTER RED – Game veteran sharp again after claim; conqueror stepped up, repeated. NEW COMMISSION – Lightly raced but loads of ability; impressed in October and threat if ready. WARRIOR'S VENDETTA - Wide trip behind top choice but on long losing streak; Rivera hot rider FIRST MONEY – Overmatched in last but sharp against frequent winner prior try; chance on best Race 8 WESTERN WOMAN – Major step forward in second local start when crushing solid opposition. VICKY VALE – Decent effort following hiatus when Linder took; only poor showing on turf. MAJESTIC JO – Vied to final furlong this spot when adding Lasix and claimed; speed along rail. 5 ROCK ME GENTLY – Repelled strong challenge in softer field when claimed; tested with these. Race 9 THEGODDESSOFSNAKES – Outrun on road trip after big effort vs. stablemate here; ends skid. MOONBOOTS – Looked more like old self when trying blinkers; fits but yet to pass stamina test. SUMMARY JUDGMENT – Rapid mare led throughout in 13<sup>th</sup> victory, 12 locally; back in one week. THEARCHERORTHEPREY – Pair of good efforts since layoff and likely to continue progress. Race 10 ARTISTIC REASON – Veteran better in past but takes significant drop; might regain confidence. HELIUM – On losing streak and failing to run to backing but can't dismiss this level for Ness.

MAKABIM – Nosed when easily second best at Penn; slow fuse but always threat with these.

SAINT MARCO – Runs well on occasion but spotty record and on long losing streak.
