NOT A DIME BACK (3rd) – DATHOSS (5th) Best Bets: Race 1 Δ TIZ RACE DAY – Led to late stages when taking plunge and enough left to handle this kind. SOLEMN OATH – Keeps firing and finished just ahead of top choice; retains Lopez as threat. 2 QUARTERFLASH – Made up ground sprinting after shipping from Turfway; handles two turns. SIRENETTA – Improved effort when easily second best with lesser; seventh start of season. Race 2 9 SPOOKY GAL – Sharp drop returning to sprint; sheds nine pounds and suited by distance. SILVER CITY KITTY – Dueled in encouraging debut and third finisher won next time; key threat. DON'T POST IT – Possibility if disregard Turfway finale; led long way in previous route. J J'S HONOR – Prominent to final furlong in route after arriving from Gulfstream; upset shot. Race 3 NOT A DIME BACK – Second best behind George Weaver runner in sharp finale at Gulfstream. KERNER – Responded well to drop at Turfway in second race after layoff; moves to hot barn. JOSH – Pushed heavy favorite to limit in much-improved effort; back up claiming ladder. 8 **RIVER'S GAMBLE – Trailed throughout at top maiden level but flashes of ability previously.** Race 4 8 JEZEBEL JADE – Classy in past and closed well in shorter event; stable clicking at 18% rate. BETWEEN DREAMS – Hampered by sluggish break and fired in two prior outings; fits nicely. ROLLS ROYCE JOYCE – Drops notch after Coletti barn claimed back yet again; must respect. BUCKS SOME – Ten-year-old mare with \$408,921 in bank seen better days but can't dismiss. Race 5 DATHOSS – Battled tougher company since return and should regain confidence this level. DREAM KNIGHT – Disappointing try in last but signs of interest in solid fields prior months. BRINDISI – Faded in route when changing barns but merits attention sprinting at this level. GEEBERT – Veteran formidable in past and narrowed gap this spot; leading rider aboard. Race 6 4 **REELIN N DEALIN – Back sprinting at amount of Moore claim; half-brother to Our Uptown Girl.** AIRMAN TREVOR – Twice finished just behind top choice and key threat despite 11 chances. WE MISS NEIL – Faltered when remote third in route but first time in claimer as possibility. DONNELLY'S HOLLOW – Kin to rapid filly Pure Lure and also from Moore barn; must guess.
