Best Bets: RON CORY RUN (6th) - SMOOTH FLYIN MIKE (8th)

Race	I the second of the second
6	KATE'S GOLDEN DUDE – Amazing 10-year-old with 19 victories; always speedy and determined

2 ICONIC LEGACY – Difficult to like or ignore plunge after chasing runaway repeat winner Jersey.

4 TAP IN FORMATION – Trounced lesser last pair and changed barns; distance may be obstacle.

FENWICK JACK – Slow fuse but shows powerful closing kick at times; ample early targets.

Race 2

- STILLWATER MOON Much improved effort when adding Lasix and blinkers; wires soft group.
- 4 MAX FORWARD SPEED Humbled by smashing winner in route; better suited this yardage.
- CHILLING TIME Possibility if throw out latest; just four lengths behind this spot previously.
- LORD SEABEE Hit board last four but had 19 chances with similar; some progress necessary.

Race 3

- 5 BUCKS SOME Old-timer hard used dueling and conqueror scored again last week.
- 4 CICI UNIFIED Passed top choice late and hinted at improvement lately; just 4-for-41 career.
- SO SWELL Remote fourth in route and likely far behind early this yardage; likely gains late.
- HAPPY UNION Retreated around two turns but third race since layoff and sheds 10 pounds.

Race 4

- 2 SUE ELLEN MISHKIN Used up after bad start and takes plunger after \$10,000 claim prior outing
- 5 CREME CARAMEL Flashes of interest recent months but lost 10 chances at this level.
- DESIGNATED Idle couple months since poor showing in slop; defeated tougher in past.
- FOREST MAIDEN Trailed latest and prior two losses at Penn; under new management.

Race 5

- SUNDAY SPIRIT Nearly always fires and difficult to handle as odds-on chalk this spot for Solis.
- MR. BOGAN Humbled by Gulfstream shipper in good try last week; vastly improved recently.
- 2 HEAT ALERT Within few feet of perfect this season and threat taking logical next step.
- EXCLUSIVE DANCER Finished behind top pair but upset third pick in March; upset chance.

Race 6

- RUN CORY RUN Improved tries going short and long since claim and drops notch after week
- RACKATAPTAP Closed strongly wide at lower level and posted 27-1 surprise here in March.
- 2 ASSEMBLY POINT Soundly beaten in last but takes plunge and terrific here during winter.
- B DR BAYTER Wired cheaper when claimed yet again and retains Haddock as contender.

NINJA PRIZE – Speedy and capable veteran crushed solid field and claimed by hot Pino stable. ENFORCER – Nailed at wire last week when nearly pressured throughout; avoids tag this time. DEVIL'S CAY – Faced tougher in New York and romped once there earlier; threat this level. WHITEWALKER – Wore down slightly easier and could receive helpful pace scenario. Race 8 SMOOTH FLYIN MIKE – Pulled away impressively after arriving from Florida; testing stamina. BIG BOYS ANSWER – Versatile and game gelding firing every time and chased rocket in last. WAR MASTER – Chased runaway winner in slop and much success at Laurel for Ness barn. JUST STEP ON IT – Overmatched in Aqueduct stake after prevailing gamely after layoff locally. Race 9 UTILITY – Eventful trip when heavily-backed this spot; often close with Ruiz aboard. JUST BE HONEST – Failed turf experiment but back in dirt route for high percentage stable. FLASHY DUDE – Drops after far behind in Maryland; might regain closing rally this level.

ONE LAST KISS – Walloped maidens in 13th attempt; contributes to lively pace stretching out.
