Best Bets: JAKE BRAKE ALLEY (7th) – BUCCHERINO (8th)

Race 1

- MOON FLEET Responded well to plunge and drops again; Mosco stable clicking at 20%.
- WILD GIRL Competing much better than odds suggest lately and chased big favorite this spot.
- SISTER EVE Signs of life lately but finished behind second pick and must put it all together.
- FLAG SONG FLYIN Close up in tight finish and roughed early in prior defeat; hard to guess.

Race 2

- PROBATIONER Overmatched in Turfway finale after taking prior pair; switches to Pino stable.
- PLANET Led long way when overmatched in route but likely better suited this distance.
- JUST BE HONEST Set up nicely for this yardage with good route effort vs. winning favorite.
- WHOOSH Stretch-runner re-claimed soon as possible by Tzortzakis barn; just one-for-30.

Race 3

- BETWEEN DREAMS Held on determinedly against stretch-runner and capable of repeating.
- ERIN'S ENTHUSIASM Victim of traffic problems in last; numerous chances at this level.
- PRINCESS CUPID Lacked usual zip in bulky field at Penn and shorter yardage in her favor.
- 2 POPTHECHAMPAGNE RO Sufficient heart and ability but making first start since December.

Race 4

- MENDED WE STAND Better than anticipated at much loftier level and sharp two prior outings.
- 3 SUE ELLEN MISHKIN Speedy filly weakened as odds-on chalk; aggressive drop for top barn.
- 4 DIVINE ROMANCE Humbled by runaway winner after claim by hot Soto-Martinez stable.
- GOLDIENESS Clear throughout in softer company and should contribute to contested pace.

Race 5

- OKIE DEN DEN Several good efforts this spot and cures seconditis in softer version with Paco.
- DR. LOU Disliked wet footing as always but fired last two attempt on fast tracks; Pino claimed.
- LIGHTNING BOSS Drops and yet another likely aided by dry surface; initial sprint attempt.
- 2 MARCHIN INTO APRIL Overmatched after claim but could regain closing kick with this kind.

Race 6

- BOOM BOOM KABOOM Faltered from extremely outside post in large field; might wire inside.
- 3 SUPER CONSTITUTION Upset even lesser at Penn when trying blinkers; yet to fire locally.
- 2 JEBOLOGIST Showed speed this far in route and capable with better during winter.
- MIDNIGHT GETAWAY Retreated in better field after layoff but much progress necessary.

Race 7 JAKE BRAKE ALLEY – Hard used dueling with vastly quicker group; prior effort encouraging. WHAT A BLAST – Finally broke alertly and dueled to final stages when claimed by hot stable. SAM WHEAT – Hampered by early roughing and drops again but sharper several months ago. 8 SOPHIA'S PRINCE - Speedy gelding failed with clear lead but shown ability to rally from behind. Race 8 BUCCHERINO – Shelved since powerful effort in Grade 2 Gallant Bob; rapid works for return. SPIKEZONE – Terrific gelding captured 11 races last year and edged last pair; obvious danger. DEBIT CARD – Improved lately as longshot and racing into peak form; favorable pace set-up. VEESON – Rare poor showing after hiatus but often very determined with finishing kick. Race 9 HARP'S HOT CORNER - Captured seven of last eight outings and testing stamina first time. BIG BOY'S ANSWER – Game and versatile gelding with only recent loss due to stumbling start. DEPOSITION – Vied to mid-stretch on Laurel turf; nearly won this spot locally last month. ARROW SPEED – Prevailed in longer test at Laurel after poor local showing; perfect with Lopez. Race 10 BULLET BREEZE – Battled throughout this level in longer test after decisive score prior outing. AARAJ – Stablemate of top choice nearly always fires and "bug" rider Gonzalez hot last week.

THE GRAYT PUMPKIN – Improved speed and effort in seemingly softer version of this spot.

BORRACHO CONCHO – Weakened under pressure as odds-on chalk but romped in prior try.
