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Best Bets: FIFTH OF MAY (1st) – REAL BLUES (3rd)

Race 1

- 2 | FIFTH OF MAY Dueled this far in Churchill route and possibly better suited this distance.
- 8 AMELIORATE Nearly scored after year's absence despite clipping heels early on muddy track.
- 5 HOPEFORGREATNESS Faded after layoff on road trip but back home; speed to pose threat.
- RAVENITE Good effort at Monmouth after edged locally in return; lures Lopez for Brown barn.

Race 2

- **5** ZOPPI FISCHBEIN Easily second best this spot and Pino stable 34% off claim; overruns these.
- 3 SHEER DOMINANCE Distant third when overmatched but strong closing kick in prior victory.
- FLUFF THE PILLOW Trounced single-winners at Laurel taking drop; shorter time this outing.
- 4 DOS DE OROS Fair showing in slightly softer field when Gallimore took; merits attention.

Race 3

- REAL BLUES Several sharp races at tough Oaklawn meet and \$25,000 claim moves to top barn
- WE MISS NEIL Flashes of interest in 11 attempts and back for tag; must put it all together.
- ARCH COMPETITOR Dueled to final furlong in route despite layoff; fitter now sprinting.
- 2 REDOUBTABLERIPKEN Distant third in compact field in return; gets Lasix as possibility.

Race 4

- JADON'S HONOR Set fractions and held on determinedly first route try; competitive group.
- 2 JACKSON'S LEGACY Fired all three outings with steady progress; Ramirez barn 23% 2025.
- GRAN YACO Frequently close on dirt and turf in Florida; absent couple months and one-for-16.
- 5 NEVER SAY NEVER Humbled by stablemate after arriving from Gulfstream; fits nicely.

Race 5

- FAST BOB Veteran stretch-runner in too deep at Penn; showed late punch here after hiatus.
- AHSAD Drops as threat in 98th career start and good form with Ruiz aboard in past.
- CRYPT Exploded past pacesetters one week ago and threat taking realistic next step.
- WE READY Often close with late energy and claimed by Pino; works out inside rally.

Race 6

- **8** GINGERSAYSCHILL Nearly ran down huge favorite in Penn mud; good late punch locally.
- 4 INSTANT VISION Improving filly second best to formidable rival two weeks ago; dangerous.
- **2** GOLD STAMP Battled throughout in Jersey and also sharp at Tampa; speedy threat with Paco.
- BAILOUT BILLY Very quick filly drifted wide nearing stretch and stamina issues persist.

TAP IN FORMATION – Drops below level of claim after dueling heavily-favored winner; can wire. JUSTINSPEIGHTOFIT – Faced tougher last pair at Monmouth and 10-year-old often excels locally PARDSY – Humbled by top choice this spot but just missed previously with Sanchez aboard. JEBOLOGIST – Failed to offer true measure again on wet surface after taking two prior outings. Race 8 DIVINE GRACE – Used up after slow start in slop but drops and won 5 of 9 local attempts. EXPECT TO BE READY – Veteran mare raced sparingly but loves to win; outside stalking trip. LEFTOVER SUSHI – Speedy filly with excellent local record stretching out again as danger. HALEIGH B -- Trounced easier recently when Diaz claimed; 8-for-24 career mark encouraging. Race 9 YOUBETTERBEJOKING – Hard used early with better after hiatus; enough left to handle these. MR. HUSTLE – Drops after Padilla claim and threat this level; long losing streak but fits well. SAILOR'S RETURN – Under constant pressure when runner-up this spot; can rate if necessary.

ARTISTIC REASON – Far from his best lately; gets Lopez and can't dismiss yet with this kind.
