Best Bets: SMILE MAKER (7th) – OTTER MISCHIEF (9th)

- PROBLEMS ABOUND Sidelined since October but ability edge and able to avoid claiming tag.
- ON PARADISE HILL Rushed to contention after poor start; pair of decisive scores earlier.
- BOSSY KATE Failed to fire on muddy footing and turf but good earlier and drops again.
- 2 PERMED Battled favored winner after hiatus in local bow; both victories achieved on turf.

Race 2

- JUST CHEESY Signs of progress with similar and draws inside with Lopez; narrow edge.
- SUNNY MAGIC Finished ahead of top choice but numerous losses at short odds in 12 losses.
- WRAP AND SEND Not much elsewhere but drops returning to dirt; merits some attention.
- IT'S AUTHENTIC Last couple discouraging and claimed earlier at Turfway; must improve.

Race 3

- ADDYSON'S DREAM Hit board 13 times but still maiden after 19 tries; competes cheapest ever.
- PEACE CRUSADER Edged in blanket finish at Monmouth; removes blinkers as key threat.
- BIG DOSSER Hinting at progress lately but soundly outrun by top choice; likely gaining late.
- 4 CELESTIAL DARK Discovered ability as longshot in softer field at this distance.

Race 4

- MENDED WE STAND Prominent throughout last after Pino claim; edge in competitive field.
- 4 CREATIVE COPY Game mare won and claimed again when outrunning top pick; retains "bug."
- ROLLS ROYCE JOYCE Romped twice since taken by hot Arce barn; obvious danger again.
- EVERLYS GIRL Moderate success in New York and new management puts blinkers back on.

Race 5

- BOTTLES Drops after no match for smashing Ness barn winner; impressive scores earlier.
- COACH KNIGHT Fair showing in mud but series of good efforts in past; fast track might help.
- 4 RILEY'S ROCKSTAR Closer than odds predicted lately and finished just ahead of top choice.
- 8 RIVER'S GAMBLE Fired this spot and overmatched previously; already shown route prowess.

Race 6

- 4 AVATAL HERO Caught late by stretch-runner at Delaware; capable of controlling fractions.
- BUNNY BONUS Claimed from last three outings and four victories last year as possibility.
- TOMARIE Dueled long way with similar and 9-year-old mare with 13 victories, all locally.
- MISS CHAMITA Gained late this spot behind easy winner; good form here last season.

SMILE MAKER – Shelved since encouraging debut racing greenly in August; fast work and Lasix CHILLING ZENSATION – Finished strongly to newcomer after troubled trip in debut. MR PUNCTUALITY – Brisk works over track and stablemate of top pick; dam retired maiden. UP THE KINGDOM – Half-brother to formidable Bump N Run makes debut for Shaw stable. Race 8 AU SOME WARRIOR – Dueled to final furlong in seemingly tougher version last week; can wire. COLONEL BOB – Far behind in slop and turf; drops but yet to duplicate debut showing. DR. LOU – Absent over two months since \$20,000 claim when disliking wet footing as usual. SCUDETTO – Used up forcing pace in route when adding Lasix; better suited this distance. Race 9 OTTER MISCHIEF – Signs of talent and speed on turf and synthetic at Gulfstream; fast dirt work. MARVELOUS MO – Good effort behind runaway winner in slop return when first time Lasix.

COOL MILLION – Roughed early in "key" race vs. open company; sidelined since February.

CAPTAIN FANCY – Eventful trip as favorite after arriving from Keeneland; needs alert break.
