Best Bets: NEVER SAY NEVER (7th) – DEVIL'S CAY (8th)

- I CAN DO MAGIC Outrun lately but takes significant drop in rare route attempt for Wyner barn.
- 4 UTILITY Used up chasing loose pacesetter and slow start previously; must put it all together.
- **2** DR. LOU Far back after three month absence and cost \$20,000 in April; drops, can't dismiss.
- PRAIRIE DUNES Determined score with maidens in 22<sup>nd</sup> try for new barn; logical next step.

## Race 2

- SHE CAN SCAT Set up nicely for elongated sprint pressing eventual winner in route.
- **8** MELITTLEFROSTGIRL Good on occasion and competes cheapest ever for 18% Solis barn.
- 4 HARD SPICE Signs of life in Florida and Gulfstream shippers excelling locally; upset chance.
- J J'S HONOR Finished behind top choice after crushing maidens this yardage; speedy threat.

#### Race 3

- MY MAMBA Moved very wide when less than two lengths behind in much tougher company.
- FAST BOB Veteran stretch-runner always dangerous with this kind; needs aid of pace set-up.
- HOTPOT Fair showing following hiatus at loftier level; upset winner this spot prior outing.
- CATHEDRAL BEACH Difficult to like or ignore plunge after vanned off at Monmouth in May.

### Race 4

- MY SPRING SUNSHINE Pulled away after dueling in decisive score; repeats with confidence.
- BREEZY DANCE Led throughout with routers to end losing skid; needs to shake loose.
- MISS CINNAMON Used up dueling better in route and returns to level of October claim.
- MIKEY'S SONG Far behind in difficult trip with classier; upset winner after Velazquez claim.

#### Race 5

- TAKEMETOTHEMOON Rushed up after stumbling start; likely favorable trip from inside.
- CHECKITUP Rediscovered ability when outrunning top choice; threat despite tricky post.
- KHOPESH Disliked wet surface as usual but winless in 11 races this season; stamina test.
- MENDELSFLY Shelved since January but capable at times; romped for Conning earlier.

#### Race 6

- FLYIN HAWAIIAN Heavily-backed in sharp debut at Monmouth; experience edge this field.
- 8 COLOMA Newcomer ships from Delaware for Pa.-bred bonus; Lynch barn excels with juveniles
- FREELY HELD Cost \$75,000 at auction and sire multiple graded stakes-winner; guessing race.
- VINO GRAY Rookie by solid sire Vino Rosso but inside post often difficult for rookies.

# Race 7 8 NEVER SAY NEVER – Easily second best to talented repeat winner; Lupe Preciado barn hot. BOTTLES – Led throughout in decisive score to boost career mark to 4-for-8; obvious threat. PLAY THE GRAY – Finished behind top pick when adding Lasix; romped before in New York. RIVER'S GAMBLE – Soundly beaten by second choice when Pino claimed for \$20,000. Race 8 DEVIL'S CAY - Ran into tiger at Colonial after narrow loss in game try locally; inside stalking trip STAY FUNNY – Improved and very quick gelding battled to final yards after Perez barn re-claim. SUNDAY SPIRIT – Nearly always fires and often involved in tight finishes; back with sprinters. 8 UNCAPTURED STAR – Walloped easier group in first local attempt; speedy but tested this spot. Race 9 10 COBBLE ROAD- Good effort behind heavy favorite in best try in ages; outside stalking trip. BRINDISI – Edged this level two weeks ago when easily second best; often forms bottom exacta.

BIG BROWN SHOES – Sharp at Delaware and showed speed locally; appears in peak form. FULL IRISH – Hard to like or dismiss plunge after \$16,000 buy; obvious ability advantage.
