TUESDAY, JULY 8, 2025 – FIRST POST 12:40 P.M. FUHGEDDABOUDIT (3rd) - NAME IT (8th) Best Bets: Race 1 10 FIRST MONEY – Difficult to like or dismiss plunge after winning and claimed for \$15,000. THIRSTY PAPPY – Pulled clear after dueling when easily second best in route; yardage suits. 8 CRYPT – Stretch-runner better than odds suggest lately and extra furlong likely helpful. 5 KEITHSENDSHELLOOOO – Steep drop after fair showing in route; claimed for twice this tag. Race 2 Δ ROCK ME GENTLY – Keeps firing but case of seconditis lately; should be prepared for two turns 8 **RIBBONSINHERHAIR** – Absent over three months and long losing streak but sufficient ability. ZONING ORDER – Competing well but behind top pick last pair; stretching out again. TARIBA DREAM – Edged slightly softer group after shipping from Tampa; entered with tag. Race 3 FUHGEDDABOUDIT – Used up chasing rapid pacesetter for much higher tag; stalks outside. 2 BRIGHT KOHANA – Re-claimed by Pino barn where she romped earlier; speedy and determined. Δ MENDED WE STAND – Trounced cheaper when Dandy barn took and merits attention again. 5 TAKE TIME TO DREAM – Hampered by slow start on muddy surface after crushing easier field. Race 4 DIRTY HARRY – Back on main track where he scored at Monmouth; drops with speed inside. 8 HEY RIVER – Rare sprint attempt after retreating in Delaware route; hot barn adding blinkers. 2 VINI VIDI VICI – Humbled by smashing winner in last and prior two outings encouraging. IT'S A PITY- Mild bid behind decisive winner but just 2-for-42 career mark and losing streak. Race 5 MOON FLEET – Easily second best behind repeat winner in tougher version when claimed. I'M A LUCKY GIRL – Quick filly drops notch and threat if able to shake loose early. MAJESTIC JO – Stopped again and plunges below amount of claim; takes these part way. NOUVEAU RICHE – Absentee from Florida surprised once at Tampa at 70-1; might need this. Race 6 BAILOUT BILLY – Extremely fast filly might last if able to control softer fractions; square price. I'LL SAY NO MORE – Pursued top pick after slow start in promising debut; needs alert break. J C'S LOVIN' LIFE – Dam won pair of turf stakes and \$110,000 two-year-old buy; rapid work.

BEE BLUFF – Lightly raced but chased runaway winner at Monmouth; likely gaining late.

5	MAXIMUS ANGELICUS – Captured two of last four races with losses in route stake and wet track
3	ANGEL OF HOPE – Decisive score adding Lasix in return and should continue improvement.
2	DOUBLE AIRO – Road warrior competed strongly at various venues and fired locally this spot.
1	GINGERSAYSCHILL – Closed huge gap behind rapid fractions in mud; ample early targets again.

5	NAME IT – Chased Asmussen repeat winner in "key" race debut at Keeneland; gelded since.
1	THREE PERCENT – Trio of solid efforts at Monmouth and Tampa; sizzling rider in Sanchez.
6	DREAMBUILDER – Competed primarily on turf at Gulfstream; Lupe Preciado barn on a roll.
4	L GOLDEN BOY – Exits best effort of career after pressured lead at Delaware; shorter break.
Race 9	
7	MISSY SIXTYSIX – No match for streaking winner in compact field; impressive late kick before.
6	TRUE PHENOMENON – Trounced state-breds as huge favorite; threat with renewed confidence
1	VOODOO YOU DO – Failed to give true measure when steadying on turn; beat second pick prior.
3	FROSTED LACE – Overmatched in Jersey route after firing twice here sprinting since return.
Race 10	
4	BRINDISI – Closed gap in recent route and suited at this yardage; might end losing streak.
1	HARLEY'S CHARLY – Improved speed when prominent all way and narrowed gap before.
3	GOLDEN WILDCAT – Recent form encouraging but prone to slow starts; moves off inside.
14	YOUBETTERBEJOKING – Disliked wet footing again but capable in past and can't dismiss yet.
