Best Bets: CAPTAIN FANCY (5th)- RACEY RUBY (8th)

Race 1

- 2 ROYAL UPSTART Hard used after slow start when less than three lengths behind winner.
- JUSTHEART Just ahead of top pick as odds-on chalk when claimed by 27% Kirby barn.
- TWIST HER Re-claimed soon as possible by Moore stable where she captured prior outing.
- MELODY'S KISS May have needed first race in nearly four months; progress likely.

Race 2

- DISCO FLASH Speedy filly switches turf to dirt and can prove difficult to catch this yardage.
- 2 BOSSY KATE Sharper in past but offered some interest in last; fast track might help.
- 5 STARSHIP LEGEND Long losing streak but troubled trip in Gulfstream finale; new trainer.
- EVERHEART Overmatched in last but shown she fits with this kind; capable here in past.

Race 3

- PURPLE LADY VERA Plunges after failing on turf and sprint; stretching out on dirt might aid.
- 5 YOUNG AND PRETTY Good showing as 6-5 favorite this level when claimed from local bow.
- 3 AWESOME SUNSHINE Brief speed before fading with similar and possible pacesetter in route.
- LU LU VATON Continued well behind loose pacesetter as longshot in sprint; testing stamina.

Race 4

- PROBATIONER Overcame early roughing for higher tag; five wins but remains eligible.
- I CAN DO MAGIC Battled throughout in narrow loss as heavy favorite after claim; dangerous.
- 2 UNION PURRFECTION Drew away from maidens in decisive score and takes logical next step.
- **4** EL DOLLAR Improved ability and gameness two weeks ago; chance with further progress.

Race 5

- CAPTAIN FANCY Hard used dueling winner and slight drop while back in for claim tag.
- CENTAUR CENTRAL Just one length behind this spot in 13th try then absent couple months.
- TARTARIAN Shipper trying various surfaces with moderate success; close at Monmouth.
- VIX Stablemate of top pick yet to offer much locally but gets blinkers first time.

Race 6

- IT'S GAME TIME Nine-year-old with 19 victories plunges after hiatus competing cheapest ever.
- 8 SAILOR'S RETURN Set pace, lost advantage then came again in narrow loss; speed outside.
- DEPLANE Heels clipped on final turn when failing to respond; best recent effort after layoff.
- ABADIN Formidable in past but voided claim for twice this amount at Penn; faces pressure.

Race 7 2 MR SANDMAN – Faced classier opposition in past and Catalano claim can handle this kind. 6 LORD WINSALOT – Narrowed gap at Monmouth and finds softest spot in several attempts. 3 GOLDEN WILDCAT – Held off rival through final furlong two months ago; hot "bug" aboard. 6 BRINDISI – Frequently claimed and boasts six local victories; edged by third pick in July. 7 Race 8 7 RACEY RUBY – Solid effort behind heavy favorite in just second race after layoff; prior loss turf. 9 PLEASANT DREAMS – Advanced sprinting after layoff and should improve around two turns. 1 PAM PAM – Weakened as 7-5 chalk when Ness claimed from sprint; pair of Aqueduct scores. 2 JESS'S MOMENT – Easily second best to decisive repeat winner in possibly best yet. 8 Race 9 2 DREAMING OF GERRY – Retreated when taking steep drop and Ness took; softer version aids. 8 SAL N LOUIE – Battled throughout when re-claimed by Thompson; retains Bowman as threat. 8 NEW COMMISSION – Disliked mud as usual in bulky field and prior try makes dangerous.

DIVINE ARMOR – Likely holds ability advantage but lightly raced and idle two months; new barn.
