| Race 1 |
| VICKI VALE – Overmatched in last but takes significant drop; enough left to handle this kind. |
| ROYAL PRADO – Drew away in stretch again and remains eligible as 3-year-old; retains Rangel |
| MIKEY'S SONG – Set pace before weakening for higher tag; shorter time between races a plus. |
| CRUISING GAL – Switches turf to dirt and most recent score at Penn; deserves second look. |
| Race 2 |
| 2 LUCKY DUDE – Fired last pair and returns to level of August claim; rooting for fast surface. |
| LORD WINSALOT – Determined score last month and Pino barn 32% off claim; dangerous. |
| SPEIGHTSTER RED – Plunges after poor showing following hiatus; boasts 15 wins, 12 locally. |
| SOPHIA'S PRINCE – Less than five lengths behind stablemate in fair effort; upset possibility. |
| Race 3 |
| BALA DE PLATA – Sharp twice on Colonial turf; stretches out on dirt first time with blinkers. |
| VINO GRAY – Son of excellent sire Vino Rosso broke slowly in large debut field; tests stamina. |
| FILLED WITH DESIRE – Eliminated at start in latest and signs of ability only prior attempt. |
| KING OF FOG – Led early after awkward break on Spa turf with N.Ybreds; likely pacesetter. |
| Race 4 |
| OLD HEAD – Hard used forcing pace when heavily-backed this spot; chance to shake loose. |
| SO SWELL – Appeared likely winner but hung final furlong; often forms bottom of exacta. |
| 4 BURNING EMBERS – Sufficient ability but shelved four months since voided claim this level. |
| 2 WHO NOT BABE – Raced sparingly but defeated similar in past; can make presence felt early. |
| Race 5 |
| 8 UNCAPTURED STAR – Used up forcing pace in much tougher field; good form this yardage. |
| NO NO JOE – Sluggish early when lacking usual speed but drops notch; Padilla barn firing. |
| LASSO – Came again in blanket finish when Diaz took from this spot; earlier success Gulfstream |
| RUSSIAN HAMMER – Slow fuse but frequently close elsewhere; chased streaking winner Aug. |
| Race 6 |
| OMEY ISLAND – Edged away after long duel when Pino claimed and takes logical next step. |

NOSTALGIA'S SMILE – Narrowly missed as odds-on chalk and re-claimed; also from Pino barn. CRACK THE CODE – Sidelined year and eligible for single-winners but upset chance if ready.

Race 7 MIDLANER – Solid effort this spot in just second outing since January; progress anticipated. GET SET – Gained late as 1-2 favorite after eventful trip; ample early targets should help. FINAL SHOT – Ten-year-old battled to final stages with similar; nearing half million earnings. 8 YO YO CANDY – Failed to give true measure at Delaware after local score; merits attention. Race 8 **GRAHMALAMADINGDONG** – Gained strongly behind heavily-favored Spa invader; up in time. WAX BOX – Overmatched in graded stake after defeating next-out winner prior try; fits well. BOOK RUNNER – Pressed winner throughout in route in possible best effort yet; must adjust. 5 FACE THE FACTS – Determined score in just second outing since April; back vs. state-breds. Race 9 9 MISSY SIXTYSIX – Humbled by smashing winner this spot and numerous big tries this season. I AM RUE – Ran into tigress when closer than odds suggest; threat with similar effort. CENTRAL TO SUCCESS – Sidelined since summer of last year but won debut here impressively. VOODOO YOU DO - Usually close and possibility if disregard last; edged top pick prior pair. Race 10 KAREN'S HONOR – Narrowly missed in better field for top stable; often close earlier in New York GOLDINESS – Game mare survived early pressure in decisive score when Danny Velazquez took

MISS EASY – Wide trip behind top choice and won previous start in second outing after layoff. SHEZA BERNARDINI – Yet another Pino claim with bulk of success this year against routers.
