Best Bets: TROTSKY (1st) – CENTRE COURT CHAMP (8th)

TROTSKY – Narrowly missed this spot when easily second best after arriving from California. LEX – Very quick and capable but stamina issues lately; series of strong outings previously. CAPTAIN FANCY – Hard-earned maiden score in 12th attempt and taking logical next step.

POSSUM – Faced tougher in routes for high percentage Lupe Preciado barn; must adjust sprint.

- 5 WEST SIDE DIVA Used up initial half mile with quicker after layoff; fitter now stretching out.
- ALICE FANTASTIC Competed well this spot in local bow in just third try over main track.
- FAUX PAS Just over three lengths behind last week in sprint; busy schedule in 27th outing.

Race 3

- 5 RIVER'S GAMBLE Humbled by frequent runaway winner but drops for Pino-Sanchez combo.
- 3 CARCHAROTH Good effort behind easy Ness barn winner and often forms bottom of exacta.
- GREAT COMPOSER Drops in first local attempt and double-digit score earlier on main track.
- KING DEIVYS Soundly beaten by top choice and winless this year; some progress necessary.

Race 4

- 3 CHECKITUP Determined effort to end losing skid and handles next step with similar try.
- 4 SHOULDHAVEBEENGONE Prominent this level but numerous chances and case of seconditis.
- HUMBLE JOE Often close with similar and Padilla-Preciado barn clicking at 29% this year.
- TAKEMETOTHEMOON Poor showing when claimed by Pino but speed inside poses threat.

Race 5

- HEY PORTER Game stretch-runner victim of early trouble when claimed again; ample targets.
- 2 ROB THE RICH Veteran with 13 victories crushed lesser in Jersey slop and 9-for-23 locally.
- ENGLISH PAINTER Absent couple months but captured three straight at Monmouth; new barn.
- SAL N LOUIE Claimed back again by Wyner barn after rough trip in last; upset possibility.

Race 6

- **4** COOL MILLION Closed strongly when runner-up; third and fourth finishers won next time.
- RONS GONE WRONG Sidelined since September but impressed in debut and adding Lasix.
- B DARK DEVIL Throw out last and signs of talent on New York circuit; danger despite 16 losses.
- LION IN THE SUN Improving gelding sharp with blinkers and hit board six of eight outings.

MR. ROUNDTREE – Probably needed first race in over year; benefits from helpful pace set-up. 8 FAST BOB – Closed big gap this spot but might prefer more distance; should be flying late. NO NO JOE – Opened long lead in hand then faded in longer test; one to catch for new barn. NEIGH DUDE – Shelved since June but much ability and threat if ready for 22% Moore stable. Race 8 CENTRE COURT CHAMP – Looked like old self in awesome score when re-claimed by Mosco. COCOA'S VIVIAN – Circled bulky field with powerful rally after claim and figures close again. DEWEY DOIT – Sharp effort when humbled by top pick and outran lesser in prior attempt. OUR UPTOWN GIRL – Game mare back home and formed part of exacta in 21 of 37 starts. Race 9 MENDELSFLY – Hampered by early trouble in latest and should continue progress with good trip DARVESH – Improved this level in second race after hiatus; Perez stable has them firing. NIXON JOY – Gained late for higher tag after arriving from Gulfstream; tricky post if draws in.
