Best Bets: REAL BLUES (4th) – ALASTAR (7th)

Race 1

- **2** ENFORCER Looked bit like old self cruising past rivals in decisive score; realistic next step.
- TRACK OF MY TEARS Hard used dueling in longer test; likely difficult to catch this yardage.
- MYSTIC LUTE Fired all four attempts for Pino barn; all out to edge two-time winners.
- B EGO MAN Eight-year-old with 13 victories and \$383,415 in bank; can't ignore this level.

Race 2

- **2** JESS'S MOMENT Improving filly keeps firing at various distances; edge in competitive race.
- PAM PAM Outrun sprinting after just missing to top choice; obvious threat with leading rider.
- **ZONING ORDER Usually close and competed well this spot in August; stalking trip.**
- BATTLING TIME Won and claimed at Colonial and shown affinity for turf and main track.

Race 3

- QUEEN VALENTINE Hard used dueling better field in Jersey; drop and shorter yardage aids.
- IN THE BIZ Back sprinting on dirt and drops from top maiden ranks; slow start in prior debut.
- 4 PUNCH AND JUDY Remote third last pair at Penn as longshot; should progress with this kind.
- WANTING ATTENTION Sire third in 2019 Breeders' Cup Classic and earned \$1.5 million.

Race 4

- REAL BLUES Faced tougher at Delaware after troubled trip locally; helpful pace scenario.
- I CAN DO MAGIC Improving and versatile gelding changed hands again after 3-5 victory.
- 4 CHINESEIAM Used up chasing speedy winner when claimed for this amount again; fits well.
- UNSWAYED Made presence felt early with similar but stamina issues persist; outside speed.

Race 5

- JAA MODE Difficult to like or dismiss plunge from \$40,000 tag; just third outing in over year.
- WIZARD SERRAT Finished full of run last week sprinting after hiatus; extra yardage plus.
- RACKATAPTAP- Second best behind smashing winner this spot and likely gaining late.
- JIGSAW Set pace and narrowly beaten in game try; speed along inside as possibility.

Race 6

- 2 OMAMA EIGHT- Broke slowly then advanced very wide into stretch following Tyler Servis claim.
- FINANCIAL STRENGTH Lost tight finish again, this time to stablemate; Miguel Rodriguez hot.
- YOUBETTERBEJOKING Shelved since June but faced quicker in past; upset shot if ready.
- GOLDEN PURCHASE Sharp drop after trailing at Spa but romped previously; moves to Ness.

Race 7 ALASTAR – Powerful effort in debut despite slow start from rail in bulky field on Pa.Derby card. LORDEN'S PRIDE – Also broke poorly in bow but advanced in promising style; route may help. JOY BOY – Soundly outrun by top pick after heavily-backed in debut; by top sire Tiz the Law. NOMOWINEFORYOU - Sluggish in debut but passed several rivals sprinting; brisk work since. Race 8 PACHELBEL – Very wide rally in blanket finish; game mare among top local claims in years. DANCING ON MY OWN – Speedy, game, and consistent mare edged similar; obvious threat. JEANNE MARIE – Held off capable opposition and stumbled in prior outing; beat top one 2024. MORNING MATCHA – Slow start against classy group in Laurel stake and formidable on best. Race 9 3 HAPPILY DELUSIONAL – Overmatched in pair of rich stakes; softest field since maiden victory. SMILE MAKER – Faded after wide trip in return and impressed in maiden score last season. HERMOSO HOMBRE – Responded strongly to drop showing improved speed in double-digit win L GOLDEN BOY – Improved gelding just over three lengths behind in sprint stake; handles route Race 10 IRISH TENOR – Step forward when dropped to this spot in second race after layoff; can progress
