Best Bets: BAILOUT BILLY (2nd) - MISSION FIRST (8th)

Race 1

- TUFF CONSTITUTION Lightly raced but competed well after layoff when taken; may progress.
- JAYJAYDEE Battled to final stages for higher tag in finish dominated by stretch-runners.
- **8** HOT ROD RUMBLE Speedy gelding sharp for new connections; shorter time between races.
- 9 ICONIC LEGACY Failed as 4-5 chalk last pair; seen better days but helpful pace scenario.

Race 2

- 4 BAILOUT BILLY Extremely quick filly romped last pair showing much-improved stamina.
- MISSPENT Won via disqualification and first finisher scored decisively last week; dangerous.
- 5 STRESS RELIEVER Ness runner must adjust to sprint but very capable and working fast.
- 3 VOODOO YOU DO- Faded after half mile in latest but series of strong tries previously as threat.

Race 3

- TRULLI WARRIOR Drops from top maiden ranks and returns to sprint; best despite 11 chances
- 2 PASTERO Good effort chasing runaway winner and two poor efforts in mud and route.
- TAP THE DEVIL Eliminated at start in last after claim and prior try stamps contender.
- KEEPING THE FAITH Outrun on road trip but last local try decent; Solis barn with 43 2025 wins

Race 4

- I FEELUCKY TONITE Upset solid group by wide margin; seeks third straight well-spotted again
- GROUP TICKET Ness runner captured three of last five outings including much local success.
- 2 CUPID'S DUDE Failed as 2-5 chalk at Monmouth but five wins this year and 10 lifetime.
- ADMIRAL'S WAVE Eventful trip in last after pair of decisive scores after bargain Padilla claim

Race 5

- ENCRYPT Pursued frequent smashing winner in tougher version this spot; inside stalking trip.
- COBBLESTONE BRIDGE Good form at Colonial and proven to handle various surfaces.
- **2** GO YOSHIDA Weakened sprinting last week and testing stamina again; probable pacesetter.
- AUTHENTIC KINGDOM Wired easier in easy fashion after Perez claim; tested with this kind.

Race 6

- YO LEVEN New York shipper plunges after retreating in return; enough left to handle these.
- REINA MAR Gulfstream invader moves to sizzling Pino barn; competed primarily on synthetic.
- HARD SPICE Improved effort sprinting and prior route try good; must put it all together.
- 8 FIFTY NINE FIFTY Advanced again sprinting and sheds weight preparing for route attempt.

Race 7 TUNISIAN SPRING – Competed strongly in bulky field on Pa. Derby undercard; fired at Saratoga BEYONDEXPECTATIONS – Finished first in game stake effort but lost on foul; speedy Pa.-bred. MARVELOUS MO - Yet another quick and determined runner; second finisher won next time. ALCHEMISM – Vastly overmatched at 219-1 in Gallant Bob but shown ability here in past. Race 8 MISSION FIRST – Bid strongly to front then tired late in longer test; figures close up throughout. FACTOR U AND ME IN – Rapid gelding in peak form and crushed lesser last local attempt. 4 MR PUNCTUALITY – Showing steady improvement and prevailed from extreme outside post. 3 RESPIRATOR – Often competes better than odds predict and just missed this spot last month. Race 9 METALHEAD - Ended losing skid with dream trip in decisive win; repeats with new confidence. 8 TORPEDO RUN – Back from New York and raced well locally in prior try; fits nicely with these.

COJELO PA TI – Speedy colt drops but hampered by stamina woes lately; Pino-Sanchez combo.

BANJO - Rapid gelding usually fires over various surfaces; stablemate of second choice.
