Best Bets: DIVINE GRACE (6th) -- CAROUSEL QUEEN (9th)

#### Race 1

- **8** WAMPANOAG CHIEF Broke through gate prior to start as 8-5 chalk; overcomes stamina woes.
- WEEK'S STRONG Closed well when finishing ahead of top choice; threat despite 12 chances.
- SUNNY MAGIC Weakened chasing capable newcomer; faced better in past and yardage suits.
- 5 CHANGE YOUR NAME Hit board in both local tries and just missed earlier at Monmouth.

#### Race 2

- 2 LIGHT MY WAY Set pressured pace and held on determinedly this spot; third race since return.
- **7** EXTRASEXYMCSTEEMEE Distant third in last after crushing maidens prior try; tries route.
- **8** KEEPING THE FAITH Used up dueling after early roughing when outrun by top selection.
- KING DEIVYS Easily second best with lesser and signs of progress despite losing streak.

#### Race 3

- 4 TOWER TWENTY TWO Excellent local mark and defeated similar when Ramirez took for 25K.
- PAM PAM Trounced rivals at Laurel after fading prior local try; among top "bugs" in nation up.
- **2** EQUUS Narrowed gap after early trouble in sprint return; handled two turns in past.
- RACEY RUBY Rebounded from dull efforts with sharp try against hard-hitting veterans.

#### Race 4

- 2 AU SOME WARRIOR Anticipated better last time but decisive score earlier when claimed.
- BANJO Speedy gelding drops again and often forms bottom of exacta; needs to shake loose.
- SIR MENDEL Trailed last out at Penn after several good Delaware outings; late kick likely.
- HOPPY TIME Posted 20-1 surprise after several months on bench; takes logical next step.

#### Race 5

- MYBANDIT Roughed in stretch behind smashing winner in bow; conqueror ran big again.
- RAGING CAJUN Sharp again in local bow and making seventh attempt; Allard barn hot locally.
- SAM'S GLORY Closed gap after early bumping in debut; dam earned over quarter million.
- ALASTAR Drops into claimer first time but yet to duplicate debut effort; switches to "bug."

#### Race 6

- DIVINE GRACE Sharp last local outing despite severe early trouble; drops notch, loves to win.
- **2** DATE NIGHT KISSES Far behind when re-claimed by Ness but often formidable in past.
- MARY'S REWARD Walloped lesser last three at Penn for high percentage Kulp stable.
- AMY MULE Stretch-runner ran into tigress when claimed again and remains at same level.

### Race 7 9 RECKER POINT – Sharp despite slow start after four month's absence; primed for this yardage. SMOOTH FLYIN MIKE – Crushed lesser with perfect trip this distance; fits despite big jump. MISTER LINCOLN – Very capable, game, and handles various surfaces; ample local success. MIDLANER - Failed to offer true measure on wet surface but numerous big efforts in past. Race 8 PONDER AND DREAM – Trio of solid efforts and gets blinkers added for Reid-Sanchez combo. MYSTERIOSO – Edged top pick in encouraging try and also just missed in debut at Penn. BUFF GARY – By top sire and half-brother to huge earner Ninetyprcentmaddie; makes debut. 8 CAPITAINE – Showed ability in slightly softer debut field but threat with some progress. Race 9 10 CAROUSEL QUEEN - Cruised past rivals in best effort of career; ample early targets for late kick CENTRE COURT CHAMP – Rapid and determined mare won impressively; bled in prior defeat. AOIFE'S MAGIC – Looked like old self battling rugged opponent this spot; 2023 local champion. MILA ROSE – Failed to run to heavy support but gets blinkers in third attempt since hiatus.

# Race 10

- CURIOUS SOUL Responded well to drop wiring similar and Arce barn has them firing.
- SIMPLY DISREGARDED Weakened late when claimed again for higher tag; wide-open test.
- MY KID SYD Overcame slow start to trounce compact group; factor with renewed confidence.
- UNION PURRFECTION Middle move after early excuse in route; beat next-out winner sprint.
