Best Bets: QUASI WARRIOR (6th) – HARMONY ROAD (7th)

Race 1

- PREACH IT WARRIOR Romped when re-claimed by Kulp; remains eligible as three-year-old.
- EXCLUSIVE DANCER Responded well to drop after hiatus and needs aid of pace set-up.
- RAMIEL Forced pace when remote third for higher tag when Carlos Guerrero claimed.
- MODERN ERA Closed strongly behind smashing winner but pair of victories from 32 tries.

Race 2

- 4 KING OF FOG Used up early when overmatched in route; prior two losses on Saratoga turf.
- JOSEPH POTATO Early excuses when runner-up this spot in compact field; should progress.
- WHISKEY STONES Soundly beaten vs. state-breds at Aqueduct; drops and gets blinkers.
- 5 LUCKY CAPO Flashed speed again but hampered by stamina woes; Pino barn clicking at 32%.

Race 3

- **2** GOLDEN PHILLY Speedy filly fired all five outings since hiatus and claimed from this spot.
- WESTERN WOMAN Just over one length behind top pick after layoff; sharp every local effort.
- MINK STOLE Closed big gap to win first local appearance; taking logical next step.
- MISSPENT Figures close if disregard latest; defeated top pair in prior outing for Lake.

Race 4

- VIX Rallied nicely in better field despite extremely wide trip; set pace in prior route.
- UP THE KINGDOM Lightly raced but plunges from top maiden ranks and gets blinkers.
- PASSIONFORGLORY Sharp in Penn bow; half-brother to multiple stakes winner Cinnabunny.
- WARHEADED Broke slowly behind heavy favorite in return; stablemate of top selection.

Race 5

- 5 CALISA Rallied through traffic when second best to rapid runaway winner in best yet.
- COCKTAIL HUMOR Speedy filly led to final yards this spot as 3-5 chalk; likely one to catch.
- JUDY'S FLYER Narrowed big gap as longshot but lone victory from 15 attempts.
- LERETHA Sidelined since May but sufficient ability to pose threat if ready for DeMasi barn.

Race 6

- QUASI WARRIOR Pulled away impressively in local bow and within few feet of perfect.
- 4 GREAT LILO Absentee showed big speed last local effort this spot; facing early pressure.
- COOL MILLION Improving gelding came again in game route score and also effective sprinting
- 2 MR PUNCTUALITY Won last via disqualification and defeated Pa.-breds in prior outing.

HARMONY ROAD –Victim of poor start at Churchill after big effort at Delaware; well-spotted. DEVILS ARROW – Humbled by Penn shipper as big favorite this level; crushed maidens prior try IRISH BANBA – Switches to Ness barn after rare poor showing; handled route previously. UP N RUNNIN – Case of seconditis in softer company; stakes-placed here in September. Race 8 HARP'S HOT CORNER – Terrific gelding with 9-for-16 local mark broke slowly when claimed. I FEELUCKY TONITE – Roughed early in Claiming Crown at Churchill; back home in peak form. TRICOLOUR – Ample ability but shelved since April and possibly most effective at two turns. ACTION HERO – Lost momentum with apparent bad step near far turn; upset winner prior try. Race 9 MAGGIE MISCHIEF – Used up setting pace in better field and won by double-digits prior effort. GIRL DYNAMITE – Moves to Pino barn with numerous good tries; Florida shippers excelling. CRUISE MISSILE – Takes aggressive drop for high percentage Moore barn; threat this level.

ALYVIA'S GIRL – Cruised past heavy favorite and claimed from four prior outings; still eligible.
