Best Bets: LOVER BOY NESS (6th) - RINGER CARD (8th)

#### Race 1

- SUNNY MAGIC Set up nicely for elongated sprint forcing pace in routes; 3rd race since return
- 2 POP NEIGH Remote fourth when claimed from debut for higher tag; winning barn adds Lasix.
- PASTERO Fair showing when dropped to this level; taken for large sums twice earlier.
- CRAIGH NA DUN Last couple discouraging but good effort on occasion; upset possibility.

#### Race 2

- MAX FORWARD SPEED Victim of bad start in October when claimed again; romped prior try.
- GUAIO Easily second best as heavy favorite this spot; fired twice with this "bug" aboard.
- 2 ALEAH ALEAH Speedy gelding plunges after eased in Big A route; hard to like or dismiss.
- I CAN DO MAGIC Retreated with routers when claimed and won last attempt at this yardage.

#### Race 3

- 2 TAVERN TIME Good effort after six month's absence when Ness took; back in same spot.
- HUGGY Finished first this spot but lost via disqualification; outside stalking trip as key threat.
- CENTAUR CENTRAL Outrun by second choice but fired three prior attempts; best needed.
- REELIN N DEALIN Frequently close but lone victory from 16 outings; likely gaining late.

#### Race 4

- 4 JOYFUL JOYCE Chased huge favorite as major longshot in return; back at level of claim.
- SHINES MADELIN Walloped soft field of maidens in confidence booster; realistic next step.
- HARD SPICE Ensures contested fractions stretching out again; Ione score from 21 tries.
- FLAMING EYES Racing into shape again and already shown two-turn ability; upset chance.

#### Race 5

- 2 CURIOUS SOUL Faded from difficult post and closer than anticipated with classier prior try.
- SCUDETTO Several encouraging efforts during summer; upset win with Martinez in Jersey
- **7** COACH KNIGHT Overcame traffic problems to win when claimed; stays eligible as 3-year-old.
- TWENTY ONE KID Drops for new management and prevailed earlier this year at Aqueduct.

#### Race 6

- LOVER BOY NESS Primed for this yardage forcing pace in Laurel route; lone poor try on turf.
- RAGING CAJUN Drops from top maiden ranks at Delaware and returns to sprint as threat.
- 4 PEACH SMOOTHIE Signs of ability at Penn and drops into claimer for 29% Kulp stable.
- CAP'N CATS Runner-up last three starts and early trouble again; outside post might help.

## Race 7 9 BAILOUT BILLY - Extremely quick filly captured four straight and wired colts with mild urging. 8 ANGEL OF HOPE – Hard used early when humbled by smashing winner; early pressure again. SHETALKSTOMUCH – Powerful stretch-runner rallied from last to first in bulky field. MISSY SIXTYSIX - Nearly always fires but exits series of frustrating losses; fits well again. Race 8 RINGER CARD – Ample early speed and three sharp efforts since hiatus; rare try vs Pa.-breds. VIXENZHYPNOTKHONEY – Good form since taken back by prior ownership; retains Pennington. CAITLIN THE GREAT – Slow fuse but close up all four attempts; sufficient early targets. LITTLE COCOA BEAN – Hard used setting pace against impressive winner; stamina issues. Race 9 SUNNY BREEZE - Chased rival which next won Md. stake in return; nearly won rich local stake. BOUNCER – Battled to mid-stretch in graded stake and excellent form elsewhere; 8-for-27 mark. TWISTED RIDE – Veteran boasts 10-for-24 local record and strong score here in October. DROPLINE - Lightly raced but very fast and determined; best needed in talented field.

1	NOHAI – Advanced outside and second finisher won next easily; good form at Delaware.
5	SUPERSONIC BETTY – Very slow fuse but only two defeats and adds Lasix and blinkers.
11	SANDY GIRL – Hit board five times this season but had 18 chances; some progress necessary.
