Best Bets: GOLDCREST (3<sup>rd</sup>) – OTTER MISCHIEF (9<sup>th</sup>)

#### Race 1

9	BIAGIO – Improved when dropped to this level and likely favorable outside stalking trip.
6	HOPPY TIME – Pair of strong efforts since layoff and offered powerful late kick after slow start.
5	BANJO – Hard used dueling in finish dominated by stretch-runners; might need to shake loose.
7	HARBOR OF GOLD – Gained late on wet footing at Penn but both victories on turf.

#### Race 2

1	IT'S AUTHENTIC – Drops notch and stretches out again; appears best despite 14 chances.
2	CHARTAGE – Initial trip around two turns while adding Lasix and blinkers; progress likely.
3	BERMUDA TRIANGLE – Often close and faced classier in past; failed twice at very short odds.
5	WINNING SONG – Lagged far behind then narrowed gap without menacing; barn 17% last year.

#### Race 3

2	GOLDCREST – Pushed heavily-favored Ness winner to limit for higher tag; ends losing skid.
8	TOOTSIE TOES – Rallied then flattened out after winning prior two outings at Mountaineer.
3	HI HEELED WARRIOR – Fair showing as 8-5 chalk in seemingly softer version of this spot.
7	SPRING MAGIC – Plunges after used up in stumbling start at Aqueduct; cost \$16,000 September

#### Race 4

2	SIMPLY STATED – Excellent speed before yielding to runaway impressive winner; one to catch.
4	BOSS LIKE BETH – Improved effort against solid opponent and might revert to rating tactics.
7	ANTONACCI GIRL – Game and versatile filly won again after claim and nearly always fires.
5	WHATTA WORLD – Making progress and closed strongly despite very wide trip; steps up.

#### Race 5

6	WARRIOR'S MISS – Lightly raced but responded well to drop defeating next-out winner.
1	BEYOND A MILLION – Rare sprint attempt after idle over two months; boasts 8 local scores.
4	TAKE TIME TO DREAM – Remote fourth this spot last week and key third outing since layoff.
5	SWEET MISCHIEF – Sidelined since summer but sufficient ability; upset chance if ready.

#### Race 6

4	FINANCE – Used up after sluggish break in muddy debut; by top sire and takes significant drop.
12	PETEY MOTTO – Speedy gelding plunges but hampered by stamina woes; dangerous this level.
6	SHOWMANCE – Progressed with blinkers in third try at Penn; Houghton barn firing locally.
9	DESIGNED BY SMARTY – Faded when distant fourth for higher tag at Penn; gets blinkers.

### Race 7

9	BACKTRACK – Altered running style when runner-up this spot; leading apprentice aboard.
8	JACKSON'S LEGACY – Rallied behind top choice and only victory in route; likely gaining late.
11	JADON'S HONOR – Shelved since August but showed ability on occasion; possibility if ready.
13	DEPORTIVO – Speed from outside if draws in from also eligible list; stamina issues persist.

### Race 8

1	MONTANA CLASS – By top sire Vekoma which won 6 of 8 starts and over million; must guess.
5	OUR GOLDEN GATOR – Full-sister to huge earner Brilliant Chase; shows “bullet” half mile work.
4	HAUNTING ECHOES – Signs of ability in both starts when heavily-backed; adding blinkers.
2	ABOLTOFSECONDWIND – Fair showing in debut but \$38,000 auction buy eligible to improve.

### Race 9

1	OTTER MISCHIEF – Powerful effort in Laurel stake after double-digit romp locally; in peak form.
10	DUKE OF GLOUCESTER – Talented stretch-runner re-claimed for \$50,000 by Moore; key threat.
9	HOKU – Deep closer exits series of strong outings including this spot; contested pace a plus.
4	HAGRID'S FLAME – Competed well three times since return at Laurel; finished first only local try

### Race 10

2	IMMENSE FAITH – Improved as longshot when dueling long way; race dominated by closers.
3	YORKVILLE – Road warrior ships from high percentage Penn barn; obvious danger this level.
4	THE GRAYT PUMPKIN – Hampered by traffic problems this spot in last; fits with clear sailing.
5	STARLORD – Overmatched lately but returns to level of claim; should offer closing kick.
