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Best Bets: EASY ACTION (7<sup>th</sup>) – TUFF CONSTITUTION (10<sup>th</sup>)

### Race 1

- 1** SECRET OAKS – Rallied behind huge favorite despite early roughing in sprint bow at Laurel.
- 4** NATURES FURY – Prominent all way when plunged to this level when adding blinkers.
- 5** MIDNIGHT FLIGHT – Distant third behind heavy favorite in Churchill finale; moves to Pino barn.
- 7** BREEZEFROMTHEEAST – Trailed better in debut but half-sister to strong closer Snappy Ride.

### Race 2

- 3** FIFTY NINE FIFTY – Advanced behind runaway drop-down winner; handled two turns earlier.
- 12** WEST SIDE DIVA – Speedy filly drops after firing three straight; needs alert break from outside.
- 9** SHINES MADELIN - Used up dueling before fading behind easy winner; double-digit score prior
- 11** JOYFUL JOYCE – Anticipated more last out but previous try stamps upset possibility.

### Race 3

- 9** IT'S AUTHENTIC – Signs of interest in better company despite 13 losses; must adjust to sprint.
- 3** LION IN THE SUN – Remote third as even-money chalk at Penn; better suited this yardage.
- 6** IMPERIAL SPY – Sidelined since Ness claimed in June but brisk works for return to dirt.
- 7** SHOWPIECE – Improved when blinkers removed in Maryland and should be gaining late.

### Race 4

- 4** MAJOR MISCHIEF – Road warrior tried various surfaces at numerous venues; logical drop.
- 9** COMPA – Faded after quarter mile with quicker after crushing maidens in previous start.
- 3** ONE IMPROBABLE – Retreated when voided claim in November but speed to pose threat.
- 5** WE MISS NEIL – Linder stable has them firing but hampered by stamina issues recent months.

### Race 5

- 3** WARRIOR'S VENDETTA – Wore down pair of capable rivals 12 days ago; able to repeat this spot
- 10** FIRST MONEY – Rallied late sprinting in third race after hiatus; also adept around two turns.
- 2** RACKATAPTAP – Veteran narrowed gap again and needs aid of contested pace for best chance
- 9** VANZZY – Classy in past and much success over years in Pino barn; near half million in bank.

### Race 6

- 4** FILLED WITH DESIRE – Humbled by pair of runaway winners going short and long; logical drop.
- 11** JOSEPH POTATO – Victim of early trouble again in compact and slow field; needs alert break.
- 6** HOUSEBUSTER DUDE – Failed to fire when claimed for this tag and might want two turns.
- 3** IMPRESSIVENESS – Disappointed at short odds several times elsewhere; must fear Ness runner

### Race 7

<b>8</b>	<b>EASY ACTION</b> – Seeks fourth straight score with aggressive drop; won five in row with Aguilar.
<b>7</b>	<b>LIBERTY STAR</b> – Veteran with 11 victories drops and formidable earlier in 2025; obvious threat.
<b>9</b>	<b>UNCAPTURED STAR</b> – Forced pace in good effort but failed to handle top pick; needs front.
<b>10</b>	<b>BORRACHO</b> – Anticipated more last time but 10-year-old with 21 wins always possibility.

### Race 8

<b>1</b>	<b>DISCO HOPP</b> – Half-sister to talented stretch-runner Snappy Ride debuts; must guess firsters.
<b>9</b>	<b>ROSIE WARRIOR</b> – Prominent throughout at Penn for high percentage barn; Lasix and blinkers.
<b>6</b>	<b>EXCITER</b> – Hard used chasing decisive winner and conqueror next finished third in stake.
<b>8</b>	<b>POLAR MAGIC</b> – Yet to perform like full-sister Aoife's Magic but merits some attention.

### Race 9

<b>11</b>	<b>DOUBLE YOUR MONEY</b> – Ultra-consistent and edged in N.Y. after defeating talented Ky. foes.
<b>9</b>	<b>HOPE'S ALIVE</b> – Major progress in just three weeks after claim; Penn shipper in peak form.
<b>5</b>	<b>SECURED LANDING</b> – Lightly raced but ample ability; romped last local try with Sanchez up.
<b>8</b>	<b>TRICOLOUR</b> – Benefits from good effort sprinting after layoff; more effective this distance.

### Race 10

<b>12</b>	<b>TUFF CONSTITUTION</b> – Hard used dueling in finish dominated by stretch-runners; Ness claimed
<b>8</b>	<b>NANCY MADE MY DAY</b> – Often claimed and seems very capable and game; below price paid.
<b>6</b>	<b>GOLDEN CANDY</b> – Veteran seen better days but claimed by Pino in November; can't dismiss.
<b>4</b>	<b>MR. ROUNDTREE</b> – Slow fuse but offers closing punch on occasion; needs aid of pace set-up.
