Best Bets: LERETHA (6th) – JAMIE DREAMS (8th)

Race 1

- 7** STAR MAN BOB – Lightly raced but battled vastly tougher rivals in October; Reid barn sizzling.
- 2** COALVILLE – Rallied then weakened with capable routers; remains above amount of claim.
- 4** LOVEMEAKAREN – Raced in closest pursuit of winner this spot and making progress.
- 3** AUTHENTIC KINGDOM – Narrowed gap when dropped to this level; contested pace would aid.

Race 2

- 1** SWEET MARIE – Passed rivals in better version this spot and showed speed in prior victory.
- 7** REINA MAR – Possibility if disregard latest; handled route in past but long losing streak.
- 8** YOU KNOW ME – Finished just behind top choice and also outrun by second choice lately.
- 4** MISS JONES – Difficult to support off last but numerous prior attempts stamp serious threat.

Race 3

- 4** AMBITIOUSLY PLACED – Far behind in latest but amazing mare with 19 wins back at price paid.
- 5** BRIGHT KOHANA – Speedy and frequently claimed; used up chasing repeat winner in last.
- 3** MISS EASY – Closer than anticipated in better field and won this spot prior try; late gain likely.
- 2** LEFTOVER SUSHI – Hampered by stamina issues lately but very quick and often determined.

Race 4

- 2** VIOLETS SMILE – Strong rally despite slow start when possible best this spot; needs alert break.
- 9** SPIRITED RIDE – Improved effort when battling throughout when blinkers removed; key threat.
- 11** MOOR STRENGTH – Claimed by Padilla-Preciado from tougher field after arriving from Florida.
- 8** RED HEAD ITALIAN – Front-runner crushed Penn opposition last pair and logical next step.

Race 5

- 4** STARSHIP LEGEND – Weakened after dueling in longer test and upsets if able to reach front.
- 6** PADDY'S GIFT – Absent couple months after trailing at Gulfstream but won prior two outings.
- 7** SHUDABEENACOWGIRL – Rebounded from two poor showings when just over length behind.
- 5** ROSE OF SHARON – Gained late in blanket finish as major longshot; must put pair together.

Race 6

- 4** LERETHA – Hard used pressing heavily-favored winner after layoff; fitter now and shakes loose.
- 1** PEOPLE GET READY – Edged maidens at Churchill when claimed in November; well-spotted.
- 5** WINE AND ROSES – Stablemate of top pick closed big gap this spot and obvious contender.
- 2** JUDY'S FLYER – Very slow fuse but offers closing kick at times and extra sixteenth mile a plus.

Race 7

6	CAP STEAK ROBBERY – Fired all four attempts with steady progress and handles these if ready
2	NO MOR STONES – Primed for sprint following pair of sharp route efforts; taken at Keeneland.
5	DESERT AIRE – Forced pace this far at two turns after trouncing soft group in return.
3	BATTLE ANTHEM – Upset bulky field of maidens in first try for Danny Velazquez barn; steps up.

Race 8

8	JAMIE DREAMS – Pressed leader long way in stake and making key third outing since layoff.
6	IN SPADES – Looked bit like old self again for 30% Dunn stable; rates off pace if necessary.
5	SMILE MAKER – Earned dead-heat in game effort this yardage; entered with tag this time.
1	AWESOME FLAY – Last few discouraging but inside speed and formidable for Wyner before.

Race 9

4	QUASI WARRIOR – Pair of impressive local scores and within couple feet of perfect; major test.
2	COJELO PA TI – Extremely fast colt claimed in November; steps up but dangerous this yardage.
10	TUNISIAN SPRING – Back home on main track where he edged tough local foe; figures close.
1	HARP'S HOT CORNER – Failed at short odds again but terrific on best and 9-for-17 locally.

Race 10

6	PONTIFFANY – Shelved three months but back in Pino barn where she has achieved in past.
2	WINKIWINKI – Battled throughout latest and drops within same claim tag; serious contender.
1	ARUMA – Very quick when breaking from outside post but stamina woes continue.
3	FUHGEDDABOUDIT – Rallied after early roughing but soundly beaten by second pick prior try.
