**Best Bets: BEYONDEXPECTATIONS (9<sup>th</sup>) -- SMOKE WAGON (10<sup>th</sup>)**

### Race 1

- 5** HOLY SYNERGY – Responded strongly to drop with double-digit romp over next-out winners.
- 1** DRUNKLE – Prompted pace under firm hold then rallied well vs. decisive rival this spot.
- 11** FAZARO – Solid runner-up this spot when rediscovering ability; speed to pose threat.
- 6** DIXIELAND CHILL – Vied to stretch before yielding after Penn romp; upset possibility.

### Race 2

- 9** VOLATILITY- Significant drop after remote third in compact field; enough left to handle these.
- 3** YOU KNOW ME – Battled throughout in another good effort; threat with continued progress.
- 8** EVERHEART – Improved despite extended duel and making key third start since hiatus.
- 10** ZONING ORDER – Faded badly behind top choice in return; can't dismiss this level.

### Race 3

- 2** ROCKET NIGHT – Edged in tight finish following nice try in “key” race; finds seconditis cure.
- 4** SKULL HONOR – Gained late taking drop when inches behind top pick; needs pace set-up.
- 5** PURE REALIZATION – Closed big gap as longshot in first local attempt for new management.
- 3** ROXTON – Used up from tricky post with above trio but yet to duplicate debut showing.

### Race 4

- 1** KEEPING THE FAITH – Disliked wet surface again but shorter yardage and fast track can help.
- 2** CONFISCATED – Very quick but lightly raced for DeMasi barn; worked “bullet” for return.
- 8** JADON'S HONOR – Sidelined since summer but solid effort at times; might fire at long odds.
- 3** CENTAUR CENTRAL – Fits nicely if disregard latest; frequently close but just 1-for-18.

### Race 5

- 4** MISSPENT – Faced tougher after claim and takes aggressive drop; six-time winner last season.
- 5** POPOVER GAL – Speedy and game mare overmatched in last and prior success this level.
- 2** SOCIETY BALL – Prominent this far in Laurel mile and cost twice this amount in November.
- 6** LEFTOVER SUSHI – Formidable earlier last year but stamina woes in recent months.

### Race 6

- 6** SPINEMJOHNNY – Clobbered at start in debut losing any chance; likely avoids trouble this post.
- 1** KNOCKANARROW – Shelved after hinting at ability in Delaware debut; sire won Vanderbilt.
- 2** PEACH SMOOTHIE – Roughed early when adding Lasix and finishing ahead of top choice.
- 5** WHISKEY ALLEY – Improved as major longshot at Penn and chance to continue progress.

**Race 7**

<b>8</b>	<b>UNION PURRFECTION</b> – Closer than odds predicted and back at level of claim; usually fires.
<b>12</b>	<b>WATCH HILL</b> – Easily second best this spot but humbled by top pick sprinting in November.
<b>4</b>	<b>MOVING TO KENTUCKY</b> – Upset sprinters with closing kick and taking logical next step.
<b>10</b>	<b>EXCLUSIVE DANCER</b> – Offers closing kick at times but last couple discouraging; can't ignore.

**Race 8**

<b>10</b>	<b>ARUMA</b> – Looked bit like old self when setting pace to mid-stretch; shorter yardage might help.
<b>14</b>	<b>PONTIFFANY</b> – Weakened behind top pick after Pino re-claimed; obvious threat but must draw in.
<b>5</b>	<b>DAKOTA SPRINGS</b> – Penn invader won 5 of 12 outings last season; good record this distance.
<b>13</b>	<b>WINKIWINKI</b> – Rapid mare but numerous losses at short odds; early pressure from inside.

**Race 9**

<b>3</b>	<b>BEYONDEXPECTATIONS</b> – Fired every outing since layoff and re-bid this spot in narrow loss.
<b>4</b>	<b>MR PUNCTUALITY</b> – Advanced late behind first pick and ran into tiger in previous defeat.
<b>1</b>	<b>SHOWTIME MATINEE</b> – Rapid gelding with excellent form at Penn; likely pacesetter inside.
<b>8</b>	<b>SON OF THOR</b> – Terrific locally last year but sidelined since July; can rate off pace if needed.

**Race 10**

<b>2</b>	<b>SMOKE WAGON</b> – Cruised past entire field in 13-1 upset in best yet; repeats with similar effort.
<b>10</b>	<b>HARP'S HOT CORNER</b> – Loves to win and sharp effort this spot despite slow start, wide trip.
<b>11</b>	<b>RESPIRATOR</b> – Hampered by difficult trip and prior outing encouraging; chance at long odds.
<b>7</b>	<b>MISSION FIRST</b> – Decisive score with lesser after outrun by top choice; possible pacesetter.

**Race 11**

<b>5</b>	<b>SHIPMAN</b> – Sharp with tougher at Laurel after moving to Pino barn; competed well in Kentucky.
<b>8</b>	<b>PALM ISLAND</b> – Used up dueling and hard to like or ignore plunge after \$25,000 Nov. claim.
<b>14</b>	<b>CISCO KID</b> – Yet another taking significant drop after changing barns again; Dunn 45% in 2025.
<b>15</b>	<b>TRANSCENDENTAL</b> – Absentee tested various tracks and surfaces; blinkers off, must draw in.
