Best Bets: AUGUSTINE RED (4<sup>th</sup>) – PRINCE COLTON (9<sup>th</sup>)

### Race 1

- 7** SMOOTH MOTION – Ran off early and used up setting rapid fractions; capable of wiring these.
- 1** KEVIN'S STRIKE – Vied long way before tiring this spot; won twice earlier prior to claim.
- 4** NOBLE GENTLEMAN – Hampered by early trouble when far back; Ness took for higher tag.
- 5** DARVESH – Edged by extreme longshot despite stumbling start; must put pair together.

### Race 2

- 5** LAUGH LIKE LUCY – Set pace this far in longer test; captured prior test at 22-1 for Tyler Servis.
- 4** GOLDEN DANCER – Won last pair going long and short at Penn for high percentage Kulp barn.
- 8** GIRL DYNAMITE – Failed as 3-5 chalk when claimed from this spot; adds to lively fractions.
- 1** VIROLOGIST – Absent since September and major gaps between starts; possibility if ready.

### Race 3

- 6** IMPERIAL SPY – Nosed at loftier level at Laurel and making key third outing since layoff.
- 2** IT'S AUTHENTIC – Less than two lengths behind top pick locally but making 15<sup>th</sup> attempt.
- 9** WINNING SONG – Slow fuse but exits another wide advance; Solis barn with 55 wins last year.
- 8** BERMUDA TRIANGLE – Frequently close but numerous losses at short odds with similar.

### Race 4

- 2** AUGUSTINE RED – Solid effort in quality field sprinting; aggressive drop in stamina test.
- 5** ROB THE RICH – Wide in Laurel defeat after capturing 4 of 5 prior outings for Ness stable.
- 3** BOLD ENDEAVOR – Ten-year-old with over half million in earnings shown he fits with these.
- 7** YOUTBETTERBEJOKING – Excellent form in Soto-Martinez barn; beat two next-out winners.

### Race 5

- 1** SAUCY MAN – Closed with rush after early trouble following claim; ample early targets.
- 4** SWEET WINNER – Humbled by smashing winner this spot and showed speed prior outings.
- 6** STAR MAN BOB – Faded badly twice since return and tries blinkers first time; can't dismiss.
- 10** FAST N SWEET – Finished behind top choice when returning to sprint; lone score at two turns.

### Race 6

- 1** PRINCESS KALAMOH – Battled throughout this spot after arriving from Kentucky; progresses.
- 3** PUT THE CRAZY AWAY – Finished just ahead of top pick but hampered by seconditis.
- 6** RINGER CARD – Edged away final furlong after prolonged duel when beating state-breds.
- 4** TELEPHONE LINE – Good effort against smashing winner when trying blinkers; upset chance.

**Race 7**

<b>8</b>	TOJO'S MOJO – Hard-earned score with two-time winners when Pino took; likely repeater.
<b>2</b>	HEAT ALERT – Stablemate of top pick easily second best when claimed for \$16,000 last month.
<b>3</b>	ASMODEUS – Faced more numerous winners twice since changing barns; logical drop.
<b>7</b>	TRUE CONNECTION – Romped twice since voided claim in October; hot Padilla-Preciado barn.

**Race 8**

<b>2</b>	BUTTER KISSES – Powerful stretch-runner won twice in December and appears well-spotted.
<b>7</b>	MISSY SIXTYSIX – Nine consecutive outings hitting board without winning; often bottom exacta.
<b>6</b>	SONADORA GIRL – Speedy and improving mare steps up but threat to shake loose again.
<b>3</b>	TIZ PURPLE – Sharp both New York attempts after \$40,000 claim at Keeneland in October.

**Race 9**

<b>4</b>	PRINCE COLTON – Trounced capable field when able to control pace; similar effort sufficient.
<b>3</b>	SECURED LANDING – Good effort this spot after missing two months; outrun by top pick before.
<b>1</b>	HAPPILY DELUSIONAL – Absent nearly four months after battling classy rivals last season.
<b>7</b>	UNCLE ARLYS – Led throughout all four attempts at Penn but likely tested first local try.

**Race 10**

<b>3</b>	MAXIMUS MERIDIUS – Rapid gelding overcame slow start in decisive stakes score; \$644,430.
<b>2</b>	DROPLINE – Talented and versatile gelding no match for top choice here five weeks ago.
<b>8</b>	TWISTED RIDE – Victim of bad start at Laurel and all 11 victories achieved over this track.
<b>4</b>	BUCCHERINO – Among best local sprinters in recent years but hard to support off latest.

**Race 11**

<b>5</b>	CLASSIC UNION – Good effort vs. repeat winner after re-claimed by Danny Velazquez barn.
<b>15</b>	BIRD KING – Nine-year-old seen better days and absent couple months but always threat.
<b>16</b>	RERALLY – Lightly raced but formidable at times and plunges after claim; must draw in.
<b>8</b>	MAJESTIC FRONTIER – Rallied behind rapid fractions then flattened out in first local attempt.
